**SUMMARY:** Plans and promotes most efficient and economical utilization of facilities, equipment, and materials.

**POSITION AUTHORITY:** The Process Engineer is authorized to take any reasonable action necessary to carry out the assigned duties and responsibilities as long as such action is consistent with established company practices and guidelines. The Process Engineer is accountable to the Engineering Manager for all phases of activities.

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Directs or conducts observation and analysis of personnel and work procedures to determine time-andmotion requirements of job duties.

Analyzes work force utilization, facility layout, and operational data such as product pricing, production costs, process flow charts, and production schedules, to determine efficient utilization of equipment.

Recommends methods for improving production efficiency and reducing waste of materials and utilities, such as improving existing tooling lay outs, relocating equipment, and suggesting additional equipment purchases.

Identifies and recommends most preferred processes to produce new sample products.

Analyzes and recommends changes to concept drawings for manufacturing efficiency.

Coordinates Continuous Improvement activities for Quality Certifications.

Confers with management and engineering staff to implement plans and recommendations.

Works with other engineers and departments to coordinate implementation of manufacturing process changes with appropriate departments.

May operate CMM and/or CNC equipment.

Prepares technical reports for use by Engineering and Management personnel for long and short range planning.

## ADDITIONAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Performs Production Supervision duties as required for sample and trial parts.

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Carries out special projects as assigned by Engineering Manager or company management.

**EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:** Associate's degree (A. A. or A.S.) in Industrial Management, Industrial Engineering, or equivalent from two-year college or technical school; or two to four years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

**REASONING ABILITY:** Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists.

Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.

OTHER SKILLS and ABILITIES: Thorough familiarity with manufacturing processes. Possesses tool and die-making or machinist skills, and have ability to read geometric tolerance blueprints.

Understanding of manufacturing philosophy and procedures of the company.

Familiarity with terminology used in manufacturing documents, printing operations, and proposals or plans.

Ability to interpret and appropriately disseminate current information relating to manufacturing issues.

Ability to use computer terminal and operating system software.
