Dear MACA Parents,

Our school is participating in the Christmas Project "Operation Christmas Child". Each student will be given a special shoebox to be kept in their classroom. The boxes have been donated to our school and our MACA seniors will construct the boxes. Students may bring donations <u>weekly</u> to put in their shoebox. It is our hope and goal that each child at MACA fills a Christmas shoebox. You may send all items at once or choose to send an item each week. If one item is donated per week, the box will be filled by the deadline date. The filled shoeboxes will need to be completed by Wednesday, **November 18**.

A suggested list of items for each week is included. Items can be found at the Dollar General, the Dollar Tree, Family Dollar, Walmart, and Roses, to name a few. The items are usually 50 cents to \$1.00. Sometimes, items can be found in the Clearance Sections of stores. <u>If</u> you prefer to make a cash donation, items will be purchased for you and put in your child's shoebox.

The shoeboxes will be collected from MACA and be transported to Atlanta to the distribution center. The boxes are crated and shipped overseas to a needy country. Last year our boxes traveled to Africa.

Imagine the joy a needy child experiences when he/she opens their Christmas shoebox of "goodies". We are spreading God's love to these children living in remote, impoverished areas.

MACA-we are counting on you to make this be our most successful year ever with this project. May God richly bless all your efforts.

Remember the items below are **not allowed and **can not** be <u>shipped:</u>

Liquid soap, hand sanitizer, mirrors, lotions, liquid toothpaste, mouthwash, shampoo, hand soap, liquid bubbles, glass items, army/war items (no toy soldiers, knives, etc.), no food items (hard candy is ok)
