 - Responsibilities include interviewing, hiring, and training employees, planning, assigning, and directing work, appraising performance, rewarding and disciplining employees, addressing complaints and resolving problems. Plans and establishes work schedules, assignments, and production sequences to meet production goals.
 - Provides direction, development, leadership and training to accomplish the company goals and objectives.
 - Reads and analyzes charts, work orders, production schedules, and other records and reports, in order to determine production requirements and to evaluate current production estimates and outputs.
 - May confer with other supervisors to coordinate operations and activities within or between departments.
 - May inspect materials, products, or equipment to detect defects or malfunctions.
 - Demonstrates equipment operations and work and safety procedures to new employees, or assign employees to experienced workers for training.
 - May observe work, and monitors gauges, dials, and other indicators to ensure that operators conform to production or processing standards. Monitors assembly performance for production and quality standards in compliance with work orders.
 - Confers with management or subordinates to resolve worker problems, complaints, or grievances.
 - Interprets specifications, blueprints, job orders, and company policies and procedures
 - Prepares and maintains departmental reports, such as service reports, injury reports, etc. for workers.
 - Maintains equipment and supplies. Replaces or repairs equipment as needed.
