

Fourth Sunday of Easter - World Day of Prayer for Vocations

We also pray for all Mothers and those that are and were Mothers to us.

Saint John of Avila was a Spanish priest, preacher, scholastic author, and religious mystic; he died in 1569.

Saint Damien de Veuster of the Fathers of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, came to minister to the victims of leprosy (Hansen's disease) on the Hawaiian island of Moloka'i in 1873; for 16 years he served, he contracted leprosy and died in 1889 at age of forty-nine; he was canonized in 2009.

Saints Nereus and Achilleus were soldiers who converted to Christianity and then were martyred.

Saint Pancras is remembered for winning the martyr's crown while still a teenager; he died in the 4th century.

Our Lady of Fatima this feast commemorates the first of six appearances of the Blessed Virgin Mary to three Portuguese shepherd children in 1917. Mary exhorted them: *"Pray, pray very much."* Her message to the children and the world: reform your lives and do penance for your sins. Pray the rosary every day.

Saint Matthias chosen by God to join the ranks of the apostles after Judas' betrayal and death, he was present in the Upper Room at Pentecost.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — The Jews angrily reject Paul and Barnabas' preaching. They then turn their energies to the Gentiles (Acts 13:14, 43-52).

Psalm — We are his people, the sheep of his flock (Psalm 100).

Second Reading — John envisions a great white-robed multitude standing before the throne and before the Lamb. (Revelation 7:9, 14b-17).

Gospel — My sheep hear my voice; they follow me. I give them eternal life (John 10:27-30).

Brothers and Sisters,

On this fourth Sunday of Easter, we have so much to celebrate. Today is Mother's Day as well as World Day of Prayer for Vocations and it is Good Shepherd Sunday. Jesus grew up in the countryside, a countryside of hills and valleys where he would often have observed flocks of sheep with their shepherds. In today's gospel he describes himself as the "good shepherd" who talks to his sheep and they hear his voice and he keeps them safe. How wonderfully appropriate then that we hear this gospel passage on Mother's Day. Jesus promises the sheep of his flock that he will forever hold them securely in his hands. How fortunate we are to have had and have mothers, grandmothers and others who have been mother figures to us and who have and who continue to guide us, protect us, love us and hold us, who have treated us with the tender loving care of the Good Shepherd.



One of the most ancient representations of Jesus Christ, based especially on today's gospel in early Christian art is Jesus depicted as a young beardless man either with a lamb on his shoulders or with a flute in his hand and protecting the sheep that gather around him. The custom of focusing on the Good Shepherd during the Easter season is a very ancient practice. During the seventh century, the passage, "I am the Good Shepherd..." was read on the second Sunday of Easter. There is evidence that the proclamation of the Good Shepherd scriptures dates back as far as Pope Gregory and perhaps even as far back as the fifth century with Pope Leo the Great. Later, during the period of the church known as the patristic period (period of the Fathers of the Church), the image of Christ as the Good Shepherd was used as an image to describe leadership in the church. Christ who nourished and safeguarded his flock became a metaphor for those who would shepherd the people in his church. The word *pastor* was derived from this image.

In today's gospel Jesus observes how the "sheep that belong to me listen to my voice". He is making a claim that we can verify. Every human being, young and old, good and bad, has a conscience. Conscience is, St. John Henry Newman taught, "the voice of God." For him, conscience is a proof of God's existence. Listening to the voice of our conscience will warn us what path not to follow, but more positively it will lead us where we should go.

Many voices speak to us through the media: experts, philosophers, scientists and other good people of great wisdom and reason. These people help form our views. Pope St. John Paul II, a philosopher himself, never belittled human reason. He wrote: "Faith and reason are like two wings on which the human spirit rises to the contemplation of truth; and God has placed in the human heart a desire to know the truth." Saints recognize the inner voice of God because they habitually listen for it.

"The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice...they will never be lost" says Jesus. Pope Francis wrote, "When we learn to distinguish [Christ's voice] from others, he will lead us along the path of life, a path that stretches even beyond death."







PERTENECEMOS A DIOS

En la época de Jesús, cuando se reunían múltiples rebaños de ovejas, la protección del rebaño dependía en gran medida del reconocimiento personal del pastor de cada una de las ovejas, mediante la vista y el oído. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús utiliza esta imagen para hablar de cómo Jesús -y el Padre- protegen a los que Dios ama, es decir, a todos. Las fuerzas que nos alejan de Dios no son, en última instancia, rivales para el amor feroz que Dios nos tiene. Nuestro favor con Dios no depende de que nos comportemos correctamente, ni de que adquiramos conocimientos teológicos, ni de que tengamos creencias precisas. Nuestra posición con Dios depende principalmente de la insistencia de Dios en que pertenezcamos a Dios, y a ningún otro. Al pertenecer a Dios, sabemos que, por mucho que nos equivocemos, no estamos perdidos. Pertener a Dios nos lleva a una vida de cuidado de los demás. Perteniendo a Dios, podemos crecer con seguridad hacia una pertenencia más plena.

LUZ PARA LOS GENTILES

El pasaje de hoy de los Hechos de los Apóstoles es uno de los varios puntos de inflexión en la auto comprensión de la Iglesia primitiva. Pablo evoca la imagen de "Una luz para los gentiles". Algunos pensaban que los gentiles, los no judíos, eran de alguna manera marginales a los ojos de Dios. Los gentiles de la audiencia de Pablo se alegran, porque ahora ven que no son miembros de "segunda clase" de la familia de Dios, sino que forman parte plenamente del pueblo amado de Dios. El relato continúa señalando la resistencia de los que gozan del estatus de "primera clase" en la comunidad, ya que la inclusión de los gentiles se percibe como una amenaza a su propia imagen y privilegio.

El libro de los Hechos sigue desafiando a las sociedades, iglesias y organizaciones actuales. La visión de Lucas de la familia de Dios, unida como herederos iguales del Reino de Dios, se enfrenta a nuestras muchas barreras de riqueza, raza, género y mucho más. Estamos invitados a dar testimonio de esta visión en nuestra vida en común como Iglesia.

ROPA BLANCA

Nuestra lectura del Apocalipsis presenta la imagen del pueblo de Dios ante el trono de Dios, vistiendo túnicas blancas lavadas en la sangre del Cordero. Una túnica, especialmente cuando se lleva en la presencia de Dios, debe expresar la verdad real de la persona. Una túnica blanca indica su pureza. El lavado en la sangre del Cordero (Jesús) sugiere que el pueblo ha encontrado mucho sufrimiento, y de alguna manera, ha participado en el sufrimiento de Jesús.

Estos pasajes fueron escritos a un pueblo que experimentaba grandes tribulaciones al vivir su fe. Pero el autor del Apocalipsis no sugiere que nadie deba buscar el sufrimiento por sí mismo. No hace que el sufrimiento sea de alguna manera un pase de entrada necesario para la salvación. Nuestros sufrimientos provienen de muchas fuentes, y el sufrimiento es un profundo misterio. La imagen del lavado con sangre sugiere que Dios está presente en nuestro sufrimiento. Dios acompaña nuestro sufrimiento, nos conduce hacia el descanso y enjuagará toda lágrima de nuestros ojos.

San Juan de Ávila fue un sacerdote Español, predicador, escritor y místico religioso; murió en 1569.

San Damián de Veuster, de los Padres de los Sagrados Corazones de Jesús y María, vino a atender a las víctimas de la lepra (enfermedad de Hansen) en la isla hawaiana de Moloka'i en 1873; durante 16 años de servicio, contrajo la lepra y murió en 1889 a los cuarenta y nueve años; fue canonizado en 2009.

Los santos Nereo y Aquiles fueron soldados que se convirtieron al cristianismo y luego fueron martirizados.

San Pancracio es recordado por haber ganado la corona de mártir siendo aún un adolescente; murió en el siglo IV.

Nuestra Señora de Fátima esta fiesta conmemora la primera de las seis apariciones de la Santísima Virgen María a tres niños pastores portugueses en 1917. María les exhortó: "Rezad, rezad mucho". Su mensaje a los niños y al mundo: reformad vuestras vidas y haced penitencia por vuestros pecados. Rezad el rosario todos los días.

San Matías, elegido por Dios para unirse a las filas de los apóstoles tras la traición y muerte de Judas, estuvo presente en el Cenáculo en Pentecostés.
