Part Seventeen: "Persecution Reveals Your Faith"

I Thessalonians 2:14

For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they have of the Jews

Persecution <u>reveals</u> your faith.

1) Persecution *identifies* you with others who have suffered.

ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus

2) Persecution <u>distinguishes</u> you from those around you.

for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen

3) Persecution <u>demonstrates</u> your allegiance to Christ.

even as they have of the Jews

4) Persecution knits your heart to other believers.
