Unifying Lesson Principle:

- 1. We desire to follow rules and practices that lead to a rightful and satisfying way of life. When there are so many choices before us, how do we know what is the best and most pleasing way of living? Paul asserts that the whole of the Mosaic Law is summed up and fulfilled in the act of love.
 - a. What is my relationship like with Jesus? Malachi 3:16-18
 - b. Do I seek to please God or my flesh? Wed: Deuteronomy 10:12-22

Lesson Objectives:

- 1. Discover the supremacy of love in relation to the other expressions of faith.
- 2. Desire earnestly to grow in love for God, self, and neighbor.
- 3. Assume responsibility for showing this supreme love.

- What are the four (4) verbs/actions that **Love** "**DOES**"?
- What are the seven (7) negative descriptions that **Love** "**IS NOT**"?
- What four (4) types of love are mentioned throughout the Bible, and which one is the most prominent? **John 3:16**
- Why are faith, hope, and charity left behind?

- What are the benefits to agape love? **Romans 12:9-21**
- Is peace better than justice? Romans 13:7
