

The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary

We celebrate the birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary because our Lady's birth introduced to the world the one who had been graced by a singular honor and vocation, the preservation from the slightest taint of original sin from the first moment of her conception. In celebrating her birthday, we celebrate the beginning of a life of total and yet ever deepening union with God - a union that allowed Mary to become God's own Mother. Thus, we "see with what sentiments of tender devotion the Lord would have us honor Mary, in whom he has placed the plenitude of all good." Saint Bernard of Clairvaux, MAGNIFICAT

Saint Peter Claver was born in Catalonia, Spain; he entered the Jesuits at the age of twenty; in 1610, he sailed to Colombia, where he was ordained; he began his work in Cartagena (major port city in Columbia) among the captive Africans who were brought to the port by ships, he welcomed them by providing medicines, bandages, and good things to eat; he performed around 300,000 baptisms over forty years; he died in 1654. TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — Who can ever know God's counsel unless God gives wisdom and sends the Holy Spirit from on high? (Wisdom 9:13-18b).

Psalm — In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge (Psalm 90).

Second Reading — Paul asks Philemon to accept back his slave Onesimus, not as a slave but as a brother (Philemon 9:10, 12-17).

Gospel — To be a disciple of Jesus one must carry one's own cross and renounce all possessions (Luke 14:25-33).

Brothers and Sisters,

On this Labor Day holiday weekend, I have a question for you. If a politician were to stand up at a public meeting to address those attending and say, "Vote for me and if you do, you will lose your home, property, family and everything else you have!", will you vote for that person? Today's gospel speaks of the importance of loyalty and allegiance to Jesus over all other loyalties, including family, self-interest and possessions. Jesus wants us to follow him radically as Fr. Ben Alforque might say, which would involve leaving our self-centeredness and embrace the hard fact that faithfulness to him might even cost us our lives. But here is another question for you, isn't that what the Apostles did? They left behind their families, their homes and all they had to follow Jesus.



In our first reading the writer of the book of Wisdom's message is that human reasoning is unsure, but Wisdom, the light of the Holy Spirit, teaches us what pleases God. Though we attempt to figure life out, it will continue to elude us. The path that leads to wisdom for us is the path that follows Jesus. Today's second reading is from the shortest book in the bible, the book of Philemon. The book of Philemon is in reality a letter written by St. Paul to three specific individuals while he was imprisoned in Rome. It was written to Philemon, to Apphia and the Archippus. It concerns a slave, Onesimus, a slave who had run away from his master and was converted to Christ by Paul. Paul sent him to his master with this letter asking that Onesimus be welcomed back willingly by his old master, not as a slave but as a brother in Christ. This letter deals with an accepted institution of the time, human slavery. But Paul breathes into this letter the spirit of Christ and of equality within the Christian community. Paul describes Onesimus as "my own heart" and his own "brother" and encourages Philemon to see him in the same way.

One of the most persistent teachings of Jesus is the call to lead a simple life. Today's gospel ends with the words: "Anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple." The call to sell possessions and give the money to those who are poor is a constant theme in the teaching of Jesus. The first Christians in Jerusalem did this, and throughout history others have done it and still do. It is perhaps the most distinctive mark of the Catholic Church. Perhaps here would be good place to explain the words "If any man comes to me without hating his father, mother, wife, children" and so on. Here Jesus uses words for effect, but not to be taken literally to make his hearers pay attention. He simply means a simple life, free of attachments, attached to Christ alone. St. John Henry Newman speaks of the personal cost of taking God's word seriously and building our life on faith: "If then faith be the essence of a Christian life...it follows that our duty lies in risking upon God's word what we have, for what we have not;... without knowing accurately what we are doing, ...nor what we shall gain; uncertain about our extent of sacrifice...trusting in him to fulfill his promise."

NOS AYUDEN A COMPRENDER

La Sabiduría nos recuerda: “Escasas son las cosas que adivinamos en la tierra, y lo que está a nuestro alcance lo encontramos con dificultad”. El Salmo 90 suplica: “Enséñanos a contar bien nuestros días, para que ganemos en sabiduría de corazón”. San Pablo habla en nombre de Onésimo, y le ruega a Filemón que lo acoge. El Evangelio de Lucas es muy desafiante de escuchar. Hoy vemos que no todas las lecciones que debemos aprender son agradables o alegres, pero sí oportunas.

MINISTERIOS Y LLAMADAS-VOCACIONES Y AVOCACIONES

Antes del Evangelio de esta semana, grandes multitudes empezaban a seguir a Jesús. La emoción crecía, ya que había conversaciones susurradas preguntándose si éste era el Rey tan esperado que los hebreos esperaban. Sin embargo, la idea que las multitudes tenían de un rey era muy diferente de lo que Jesús ofrecía. El rey que esperaban era un sumo sacerdote, un Mesías. Este no era el reino que Jesús predicaba, sino uno de dolor, de llevar la cruz y las cargas, un reino al que no hay que acercarse a la ligera, sino hacer planes y esfuerzos serios para ayudar a construirlo. Con demasiada frecuencia vemos este pasaje pensando que es duro y que se refiere sólo a los llamados a la vida religiosa. La verdad es que todos estamos llamados a la caridad. Tomar nuestra cruz no es una llamada a sufrir por sufrir, sino a perseguir el bien y la justicia.

EL COSTO DEL DISCIPULADO

The Cost of Discipleship (El costo del discipulado) es el nombre del poderoso libro escrito por Dietrich Bonhoeffer, el teólogo que fue asesinado en un campo de exterminio nazi. Hoy vemos rupturas en las relaciones familiares por la religión y la política. Vemos a los que olvidan cómo perdonar, y a los que nunca se les enseñó a amar. Bonhoeffer ofreció un mensaje que podría aplicarse a cualquier historia sacada de las noticias de la noche. Dijo que el amor cristiano no distingue entre enemigos, salvo que los que odian más amargamente están más necesitados de amor. De hecho, sólo deberían esperar el amor incondicional de un cristiano. Bonhoeffer concluye que, si uno no está dispuesto a amar indiscriminadamente como discípulo de Cristo, entonces no es cristiano en absoluto. Cuando Jesús nos pide hoy que tomemos nuestra cruz, nos está pidiendo que asumamos la disciplina del amor cristiano.


