We'll sing and shout the victory.*

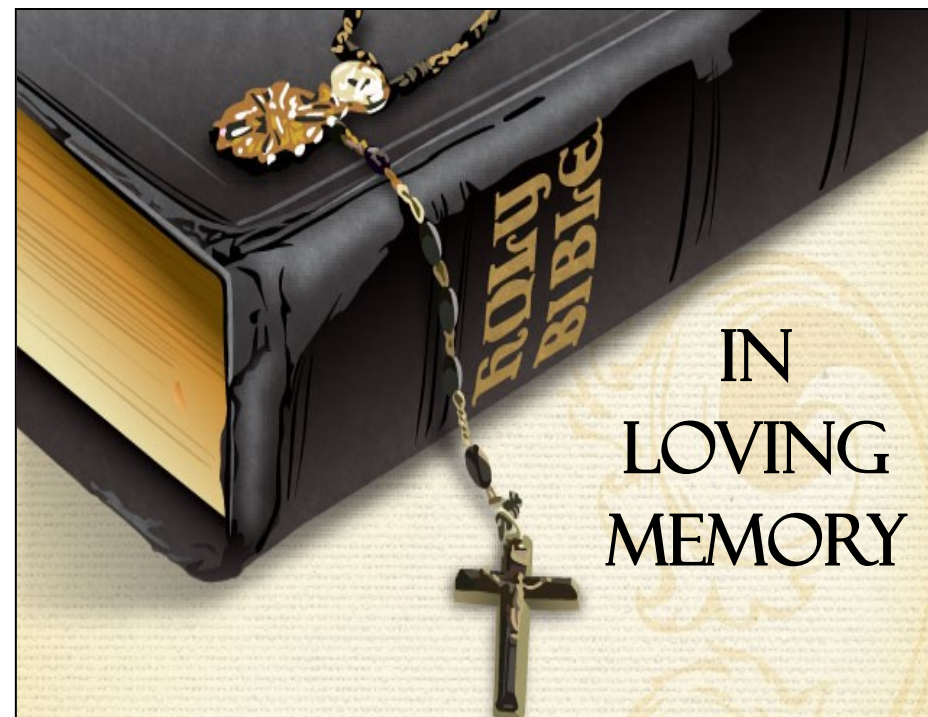
