

Sermon Excerpts:

"Worshipping God by Respecting and Caring for God's Creation" Sermon II

September 12, 2021

Genesis 2:15 "The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it."

Currency of Wellness: The state of being healthy physically, socially, economically, ENVIROMENTALLY, and spiritually within a church or ministry, the neighborhood, the town and city, nation, or the earth, especially as the result of deliberate effort. Sustainable wellness requires regenerative and circulatory flow of material, human, financial, and natural resources.

Exodus 23:10-11 "For six years you are to sow your fields and harvest the crops, but during the seventh year let the land lie unplowed and unused. Then the poor among your people may get food from it, and the wild animals may eat what is left. Do the same with your vineyard and your olive grove."

Matthew 6:26 "Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them."

- The responsibility to care for the environment continues to each generation. We cannot embrace the parts of the Bible about soul issues and ignore the parts relevant to practical concerns.
- We are called for engaging faithfully in environmental justice work, agricultural production, healthy food access and food systems, creation care ministries, land use issues, policy advocacy, and environmental management.
- Urging, insisting, and pleading with people to hold a continual awareness of global, national, or even local interconnectedness is a counsel of righteousness.

Four Action Steps to Worshipping God by Respecting and Caring for God's Creation:

- 1) Consider your own connection to nature.
- 2) Foster greater awareness of your natural surroundings.
- 3) Actively appreciate the good and growing things that surround us.
- **4)** Accept that better understanding can lead to a better change.
