Dear Patient,

Before you begin treatment at the Norfolk Center for Cancer Care & Hematology it is very important that you are aware of what your insurance benefits are. Due to the large number of insurance carriers that we bill, it is necessary for you to review with your insurance company(s) the following:

Copays

1. Any calendar year deductibles you may be responsible for before your insurance begins to pay services that **may not** be covered by your insurance company and are billable to you.
2. If you have limited coverage what percentage of the allowable will you be responsible for.
3. Does your insurance have a lifetime maximum or CAP?

Regardless of whether we are a participating or nonparticipating practice, it is still your responsibility to understand what your insurance will or will not cover.

I have read and understand that in the event that my insurance company does not pay for services and treatment rendered to me I will be responsible for any self pay balance that is sent to me for payment. In the event that an estate becomes involved in settling my account it is my wish that my debt be paid in full for services rendered to me by The Norfolk Center for Cancer Care & Hematology.
