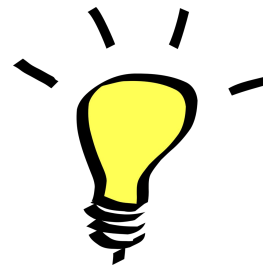


Things to Know for September!

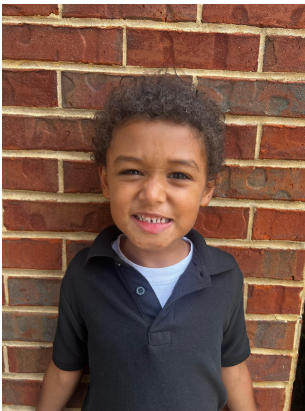
