REQUIRED TOOLS

- Tool Pouch
- Belt (Suitable for tool pouch)
- Pencil
- Pocket Knife
- Flashlight
- Padlock for Lockout/Tagout
- Channel Lock Pliers – **2 Pair**, #420 or equivalent (Grooved, not slip joint type)
- 9" Side Cutting Pliers
- Telecom Snips/Scissors
- Wire Strippers (Small wire sizes)
- Crimp Tool, indenting (Thomas & Betts type)
- Tech Driver with assorted tips
- Screw Drivers, Assorted (3/16" x 4", 1/4" x 6", #2 Phillips, #3 Phillips)
- Electrician's/Claw Hammer – fiberglass handle preferred
- Hacksaw Frame with blade storage
- Keyhole Saw or Sheetrock Saw
- Scratch Awl (solid metal or metal through handle)
- Torpedo Level, 9" Magnetic
- Punch Down Tool (66 & 110 blades; you provide first blade set, then employer will provide)
- Pick and Spudger (Dental type)
- Tap Wrench (T-handle type)
- Crescent Wrench, 10" adjustable
- 6' Wooden Folding Rule (Inside Reading)
- 7" or 8" Diagonal Side Cutting Pliers
- 6" Long Nosed Pliers (Needle Nose)
