

Assist-A-Grad Scholarships FAQ's

What is Assist-A-Grad?

The Assist-A-Grad Scholarship Program is open to High School graduating seniors. These are scholarships provided by local community members.

What is the Process?

The process starts with the publication of the annual Guide and opening of the application period at the end of January. The deadline to submit applications is **March 3, 2022. Due to Covid, there will be no face-to-face interviews. Sponsors will have the option to either paper screen only or conduct virtual interviews.**

How Many Scholarships can I apply to?

Students can apply for two (2) scholarships and the requirements and amounts vary.

Where do I get an application and a list of Scholarships?

Applications are available on the Assist-a-grad.org website. The form is a .pdf fillable form. Please be sure to save a copy. Important instructions are included with the Application Form.

How will I know if I was selected?

Once sponsors have reviewed applications and made selections, students will receive an email notifying them of the results.

How Will I Receive my Award?

Award Certificates will be distributed by each school at an Awards Ceremony.

How Can I Increase my Chances of receiving a Scholarship?

It is extremely important that you following the instructions exactly as directed. Assist-A-Grad may reject your application if not completed correctly
