Town Board Meeting
April 11, 2018

1. The Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Patrick Wilcox at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall.
2. Pledge of allegiance was recited.
3. Roll call: All Board Officials, Town Clerk & Treasurer present.
4. Treasurer's Report was given as follows all balances as of March 31, 2018:
 - Checking Account: Beginning balance - \$47,879.09, outstanding checks - \$360.59, Final working balance - \$47,518.50 includes interest of \$6.00
 - Money Market Account: \$462,534.52 includes interest of \$269.25
 - Highway Equip. Maintenance Account - \$3,131.07
 - Includes Quarterly Interest of \$1.54
 - Tax Account - \$300.00
5. **Chairman's Report:**
 - a. The biggest talk of the town is the weather – first it's winter than its spring than its winter again. Are you ready again: If it does happen let's hope it's the last!!!
 - b. We have started to gear up for summer – some of the wing blades off, the equipment has been serviced and stored. I have been in contact with contractors and the gravel companies in preparation.
