TUESDAY of most months (in conjunction with the regular cattle auction). Cattle marketed in these lots average between 550-700 lbs and must be preconditioned according to the specifications in this document.

Calves not matching the parameters for a given load lot (too light/heavy, heavy ear/pigmentation, frame differences, etc.) will have the option to be taken back by the seller or sold following the load lot, carrying ear tags and described as adhering to preconditioned protocol.

- 1. All calves must be weaned at least 45 days prior to sale.
- 2. All calves must be either heifers or steers (properly castrated and healed)
- 3. Heifers must be guaranteed open (a \$100 fee will apply to bred heifers).
- 4. Calves may be implanted or non-implanted
- 5. All calves must be **dewormed** within the last 60 days
- 6. Calves must be identified with a CCALE EID-tag; Steers in the right ear, heifers in the left ear.
- 7. No horned or exotic cattle (excessive ear/navel/dairy influence/etc.)

## \*Last vaccine must be administered at least 2 weeks prior to Sale Date\*

- 8. All calves must have received two rounds of a respiratory vaccine. \*At least one round must be with Vista Once SQ- modified live vaccine (MLV) containing IBR, BVD Types 1&2, BRSV, and PI3 w/ Pasteurella Multocida & Mannheimia Haemolytica
- 9. All calves must have received two rounds of a Clostridial vaccine including Somnus
  - \*Respiratory & Clostridial vaccines may be administered together\*

\*\*For optimal animal health, cattle should not be vaccinated in a heat index above 85° and should be handled using low stress practices\*\*

Cattle must be received between 8:00am and 10:00am on the day of shipment. Cattle will be weighed upon arrival with a 2% shrink.
