Dedication of the Wall Bible Background: Nehemiah 12:27-43 Printed Text: Nehemiah 12:27-36, 38, 43 KJV/NLT Devotional Reading: Psalm 96

Aim for Change:

- KNOW that a part of our worship is thanking God and celebrating our restoration.
 - 1. Do I really **KNOW** that a part of my worship is thanking God and celebrating my restoration.
- **RECALL** times when God restored us.
 - 2. Can I **RECALL** times when God restored me?
- **THANK** God for restoring us.
 - 3. How often do I **THANK** God for restoring me?

Devotional Reading: Mon: Celebrating God's Greatness – Psalm 96:1-9; Tue: Celebrating the Lord's Coming – Psalm 96:10-13 – 1 Chronicles 16:23-33

- (vv. 1-4) How does God show me His salvation from day to day? How well do I tell others of His greatness and what He's done for me?
- (vv. 7-9) How do I give unto the Lord? What kind of offering do I bring to the house of the Lord? Psalm 29:1-2
- (v. 13) Am I prepared to be judged by the Word of Truth? Psalm 58:11

Focal Verses - Celebrating a Completed Task - Nehemiah 12:27-36, 38, 43

1. Dedication and Purification (vv. 27-36)

- (v. 27) Have I been sought out to do God's work? How am I keeping my dedication to the Lord? Am I using my time, talent, abilities, and gifts for the Lord with thanksgiving and gladness? Numbers 7:10
- (vv. 28-29) Am I only fellowshipping with my congregation and not with others around?
- (v. 30) What have I done to purify myself for the Lord? How can I purify what God has given me? Exodus 19:10, 14; Numbers 8:5-9
- (vv. 31-36) How well do I follow directions from the man of God? Would what I listen to be pleasing to God's ears?

2. Restoration and Thanksgiving (vv. 38, 43)

- (v. 38) Does my thanksgiving to God stay round about me?
- (v. 43) Is my thanksgiving to God an example for others to rejoice? Are my sacrifices to the Lord above and beyond or the bare minimum, if at all? 2 Chronicles 20:27-30

Daily Readings:

- Wednesday: Celebrating God's Blessings Deuteronomy 12:2-7
 - o (vv. 2-4) Do I think I'm too strong in the Lord to not be tempted? Has my own way of worship led to idolatry?
- Thursday: Celebrating Freedom from Oppression Nahum 1:6-15
 - o (vv. 6-8) Why do I try to hide from God if I'm supposed to trust in Him?
- *Friday:* Celebrating the Restored Nation **Jeremiah 30:18-22**
 - o (vv. 19-20) How has my voice of thanksgiving been multiplied? Have I silenced my thanksgiving?
- Saturday: Celebrating the Restored Jerusalem Isaiah 66:10-14
 - o (vv. 13-14) Does God's mercy cause me to rejoice and flourish? Does my ignorance of His word cause me to dry up and wither?
