#### 17. Councillor's Concerns

Mayor Craig wished to extend sympathies to the family of Norman Gaudet, a former resident of Blacks Harbour, and who was also a police officer for 11 years for the village. Norman was the father of St. George CAO, Jason Gaudet.

Mayor Craig also wished to extend heartfelt sympathies to the family of Denis Saulnier, a resident of Blacks Harbour since 1979, and an employee for Connors Bros. for over 40 years. To his wife, Della, daughter, Claudette, grand-daughter, Emily, and son-in-law, Jamie, our sympathies are extended.

Councillor Thompson took the opportunity to give some insight into what current issues are around recreation in the village. We have reached out to the school. He personally spoke to the principal, and the director of maintenance for the district. We are working on initiatives that involve resurfacing the basketball court, a small court just outside of the school, lots of interest from the school to partner with us, so think it is important that we build around the school, as a hub in the community. Just to let everyone know that we are working on some recreation facilities in that area, and partnering with the school. We are also looking at the field by the old ball diamond and some other areas that have room for additional facilities there. The school is very interested in working with us so a lot of good things are going to come from that.

Councillor Ritchie spoke about our Food Pantry. It has had stuff taken from it and scattered near and around it. She asked that we all come together as a community to keep an eye on it, to let people know when it is low on stock and to reach out and address when it needs to be restocked. If we can all just work together to guide kids to make good choices and educate them around it. It is not something to be played with, as people genuinely need and use it.
