Wednesday 7 July, between 9.00am – 5.45pm. Thank you to everyone for getting your booking forms back to school promptly. Time slots have filled up quickly.

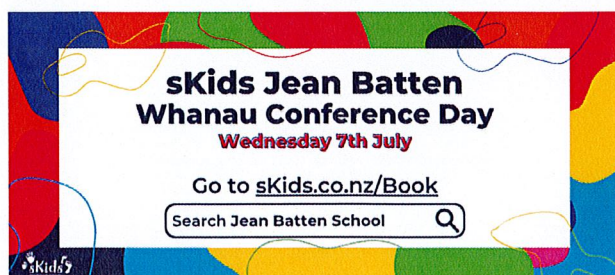
Please make sure if you have not yet booked a conference time with your child's classroom teacher please fill in a form ASAP. **Appointments will be 15 minutes long**

sKids is open in the school hall if you need care for your child on conference day.

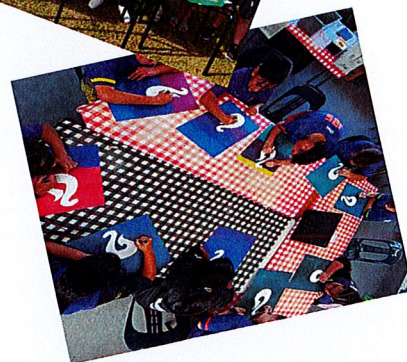
WHAT GOES DOWN AT JBS

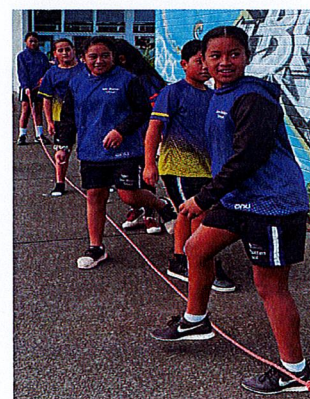
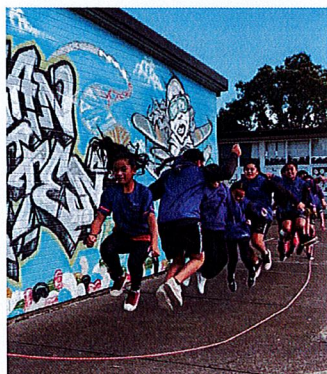
Students have been involved in a host of learning activities such as arts and crafts, tiktok, digital technology, baking, minecraft, brainteasers and science experiments to name a few.

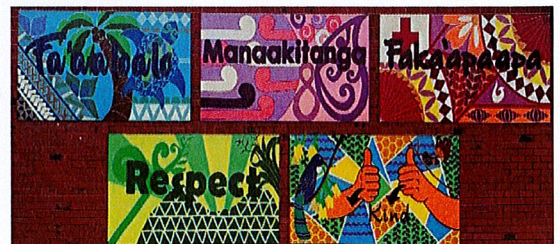
