From The Community Spiritual Director

The campground also had huge numbers in our Marketplace camp and in our junior and senior high camps.

So, to look at our year from another perspective I will tell you that I personally saw many lives changed in every event I was privileged to attend at the camp. This is what excites me so much. Yes indeed, 2017 was a great year in many ways for our community and for the other camp ministries.

The purpose of Emmaus is to equip Christians to be leaders in their church and I have seen that happen in many of the people who have taken part in the walk. One of the ways I would like to see us build on what God has done for us is to encourage everyone, and especially those who have been a part of our community for a few years (or several years), to make attendance at gatherings a priority. I certainly don't expect everyone to attend every gathering, I don't make them all myself, but we need to make sure the excitement is there for the people who will be attending walks in 2018 and will hopefully be attending gatherings to keep the fire burning within their hearts.

So, mark the 4th Tuesday on your calendar and come out and be the blessing God has intended you to be. If you bless no one else with your presence rest assured that you will be blessing me.
