I THESSALONIANS

Part Thirty Nine: "Excellence in Moral Purity, Part 5"

I Thessalonians 4:7

For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

Moral Purity is a matter of my <u>pursuit</u> of <u>holiness</u>.

- 1. Holiness and uncleanness are opposite destinations. You will arrive at one or the other, but not both.
- 2. *Holiness* is the destination for which every believer ought to be <u>striving</u>.
 - a. Holiness is who God is. I Peter 1:15-16.
 - b. *Holiness* is the only <u>means</u> by which we can see God. Hebrews 12:14.
 - c. Holiness prepares us for Christ's return. I John 3:2-3.
 - d. Holiness pays us back in eternal dividends. Romans 6:22.
- 3. When you got saved, your direction <u>changed</u> from *uncleanness* to *holiness*. Romans 6:19.
- 4. Every failure in moral purity is a <u>setback</u> in the pursuit of my call to holiness.
