

ABOUT The Author

Dr. D. James Kennedy was born in Augusta, Georgia, was reared in Chicago, and has spent most of his adult life in Florida. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Tampa, his Master of Divinity, *cum laude*, from Columbia Theological Seminary, and his Master of Theology, *summa cum laude*, from the Chicago Graduate School of Theology. He received the Doctor of Divinity degree from Trinity College and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, and his Ph.D. from New York University.

Dr. Kennedy has lectured and taught in dozens of seminaries, colleges, and countries and at the general assemblies of a number of denominations. He has spoken to over 100,000 ministers and seminary students on the subject of lay evangelism, and he has been a regular member of the faculty of the Billy Graham schools of evangelism.

The Results of This Ministry

The Evangelism Explosion ministry has been in continuous operation in the Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, for the past 33 years. Up to 700 people have gone out weekly to share the Good News of Christ with others. God's gracious working through this effort has been exciting to observe. The church has grown from 17 to about 9,000 members and from one minister to 19. Of more importance than membership figures is the actual attendance on Sundays. The attendance has reached more than 12,000 on a peak Sunday morning. In the area of stewardship, the church has gone from home-mission support to a budget of more than \$30 million. Approximately 150 families from the church have gone into full-time Christian service. Coral Ridge now telecasts its services to some 25,000 cities and communities and 35 countries. But Evangelism Explosion isn't confined to Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. Pastors have been trained in every nation on every continent and have returned to equip their laypeople for personal evangelism and discipleship, and the Evangelism Explosion ministry has been planted in every nation of the world.
