RAINS FINALLY ARRIVE!

Shelter Cove is currently receiving periods of heavy rain which may cause damage to county culverts and roads. If there are road conditions needing repair in your neighborhood, call <u>Humboldt County Public</u> Works directly at 445-7421 and the repair request will be logged. Early reporting can stop damage from becoming more serious.

Holiday Announcement:

The District offices will close on Friday, November 11th in observance of Veteran's Day and November 24th and 25th in observance of Thanksgiving Day.

Fire Extinguisher Recharge:

The community may bring their fire extinguishers to the Fire House on the morning of Thursday, December 8th, for recharging by Eureka-Humboldt Fire Extinguisher, phone 822-2517. The cost of this service will depend on the unit size.

BURNING RESTRICTION LIFTED

The state burn ban has now been lifted and burning is allowed with a valid Air Quality Management District burn permit. Annual permits run from January to December, take a week to process and are available at the Fire Station/District office. Completed applications and the residential burn permit fee must be sent to the AQMD office at 707 L Street, Eureka, CA 95501. For a quicker turnaround you may apply online at http://www.ncuaqmd.org/index.php?page=burn.puermits. Your permit will be emailed to you.

Burn day information for Shelter Cove (Zone 1) is available each day by calling 1-866-BURN-DAY. Please have your permit on-site while burning.

SHELTER COVE IS A FIREWISE COMMUNITY Defensible Space Around Your Home:

Even though we have received a few days of rain, Shelter Cove may still experience intermittent dry conditions. Please make an effort to clear away all flammable materials from within 30ft from your home. This includes highly flammable vegetation and landscaping materials, firewood, construction materials, leaves and needles in gutters and fuels such as gasoline tanks. Mow lawns regularly and limb trees up 6 to 10ft from the ground. Create a 'fire-free' area within 5ft of the home, using non-flammable landscaping materials and/or high-moisture-content annuals and perennials.

Please log your hours worked clearing, piling and burning vegetation, and money spent hardening your home to wildfire by using a Firewise Volunteer Hourly Work Sheet found on the District's website Fire Dept Page - http://www.sheltercove-ca.gov/fire-department-page.html and bring the completed form to the District office for inclusion in Firewise recertification. This information will greatly help to maintain Shelter Cove's status as a Firewise Community for the 2023 season.
