Paul wrote that "our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us," when Christ returns. (Romans 8.18) But, that glory even begins now as we live in Christ.

And so, let us stop looking down and start looking up. Let our focus in life be on the blessings and not the problems. Let our conversations be centered on the positives and not the negatives. Remember the sun will come out tomorrow, but the Son is always shining and raining down blessings on us every day.
