The Psalms are particularly good for this, no matter what book, chapter or verse you choose for your prayer time, whether it's your favorite, very familiar, or a part of the Bible you rarely leaf through, let the Spirit lead you into a more meaningful quiet time with the God of the universe. And one thing will soon become clear to you, you will never say the same old things about the same old things.
