## I THESSALONIANS Part Nine

## I Thessalonians 2:3-4

For our exhortation was not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile: But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which trieth our hearts.

- A. Paul's Faithfulness. 1-12.
- 2. Paul's Motives. 3-4.
  - a. Paul's motives for preaching were not rooted in:
    - 1) False <u>doctrine</u>. *Not of deceit*.
    - 2) An impure heart. Nor of uncleanness.
    - 3) A hidden agenda. Nor in guile.
  - b. Paul's was driven and guided by:
    - 1) The opportunity given to him by God. as we were allowed of God
    - 2) The <u>responsibility</u> entrusted to him by God.

to be put in trust with the gospel

- 3) His focused desire to please God. not as pleasing men, but God
- 4) His awareness of accountability to God. God, which trieth our hearts

## **GREAT TRUTHS**

- 1. Your motives are important because they will ultimately determine your <u>actions</u>.
- 2. We each must learn to <u>recognize</u> and <u>eliminate</u> unscriptural motives in ourselves.
- 3. Focus less on self-promotion and self-defense, and more on self-examination.
