

Saint Alphonsus received his degrees in civil and canon law at sixteen; he left a promising law career to enter the priesthood; driven to prayer, he heard the Lord's voice: "Leave the world and give yourself to me;" in 1732 he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (the Redemptorists); he died in 1787. *MAGNIFICAT*

Saint Eusebius the first Bishop of Vercelli, a town in northern Italy; an opponent of the Arian heresy, a false teaching that Jesus was not really divine, this caused confusion in the church for two centuries; due to his opposition, he was exiled and eventually returned to his diocese; he died in 371.

Saint Peter in 1856 he founded the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament, he wrote, "We must quickly get to work to save souls by the divine Eucharist, to awaken [a world] numbed in dormant apathy because they don't know the gift of God, Jesus, the Eucharistic Emmanuel." He died in 1868. *MAGNIFICAT*

Saint John Vianney desired from a young age to be a priest; popularly known as the Cure of Ars; he wrote, "Jesus Christ, who cares for all, would not in his unbounded charity leave his faithful without help and consolation in that most momentous and critical hour of their lives, and has, therefore, instituted a special sacrament for the sick and dying. Through this sacrament they are to receive consolation, and material and spiritual help." He died in 1859.

Basilica of Saint Mary Major the date marks the dedication of Rome's first Marian basilica, consecrated to Mary by Pope Sixtus III around the year 435. It is said that Mary signaled her choice of the church's site with an August snowfall.

My Brothers and Sisters,

How much of our lives is dominated by concerns over money and possessions? At one extreme we can be desperate to survive from day to day; at the other extreme we can become addicted to increasing our wealth. Many of us work hard to make life comfortable for ourselves and our families, working for that promotion or raise, saving enough for a good retirement. Our readings today are a wonderful antidote to our culture's attitude that the accumulation of material wealth should be everyone's goal. "Vanity of vanities!" cries the narrator in our 1st reading ridiculing the idea we have total control over the rest of our lives. St. Paul, in our 2nd reading invites them and us, to refocus our attention. It is through the raising of Christ from the dead that we are called to rise above things of the world which keep us from being Christ-like. Setting our focus on Christ we will grow rich in God. As St. Paul says, "Seek what is above" (Col.3:1).



A Christmas Carol by Charles Dickens is one of the best-loved stories about Christmas ever written. First published in 1846, it is thought to have had the astounding effect of renewing the celebration of Christmas itself throughout Great Britain. In the space of one night, the miser Scrooge is subject to visitations from the ghost of his former partner Jacob Marley as well as those of Christmas past, present and future. These experiences put Scrooge in touch with the bright young man he once was, the terrifyingly destructive person he has become and the devastation that lies ahead both for him and for others if he does not change his ways. The effect when he awakes from this series of nightmares on Christmas Day is a total transformation. He emerges as a person now full of joy and kindness and perhaps even a sense of mischief. The ghostly guides from the previous night have put him in touch with his deeper self. It has taken a mixture of remembered joy and good times as well as anxious fear to achieve this change, but the new Scrooge becomes a symbol of how we should live in generous concern both for our families as well as for our neighbors and friends. Where there was meanness in Scrooge there is now openness, penny-pinching is replaced by acts of great generosity and reconciliation. If we stop for a minute to think about it, the parable of the man building bigger barns has a touch of Scrooge's ghost of Christmas future.

In a consumer-oriented society such as ours, the lesson from today's readings is counter-cultural. We are challenged to reject the idea that money brings happiness. We are encouraged to build wealth instead of what matters to God. However, there is a miracle in all this, and that miracle is that many people still manage to put their energies into concern for others and seek to build up community in whatever way they can. Recall those wonderful people we talked about two weeks ago who cook hot breakfast for those in need on Saturday at Catholic Charities. These are the ones who listen to the inner voice of love that express the human heart at its best or as Tiny Tim would say in A Christmas Carol: "God bless us, every one!"


his face changed in appearance, it shone like the sun, and his clothing became dazzling white as light, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them.

**Rev. Ephraim Arciga, MSC
Parochial Vicar**

Welcome to St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish Fr. Ephraim!

Rev. Ephraim Palma Arciga, MSC, was ordained to the priesthood in 2000 in the Philippines, and his assignment as a parochial vicar at St. Catherine of Alexandria Church marks his first position in the United States.

Fr. Ephraim, as he is known, is a member of the MSC Philippine Province under the administration of the USA/MSC Province.

Fr. Ephraim was born on March 17, 1970 in Santa Cruz, Lanuza, Surigao del Sur province in the Philippines to Pedro Veñas Arciga and Maria Aciquia Palma and was the fifth-born in a family of seven children. He is a 1991 graduate of San Nicolas

College in Surigao City on the island of Mindanao and received his bachelor of arts after majoring in English.

His path to the priesthood began with a one-year novitiate beginning in 1993 in Quezon City under novice master Fr. Generoso Sabio, MSC, a former pastor at St. Catherine's. He studied from 1994 to 1999 at the Institute of Formation and Religious Studies and from 1997 to 1999 at the Maryhill School of Theology, both in Quezon City, on the island of Luzon. His first profession came in 1994 and his final profession in 1999.

Fr. Ephraim was ordained a deacon on Dec. 6, 1999 and entered the priesthood June 8, 2000 when he was ordained by Bishop Irineo Amantillo, CSSR, D.D. at Virgen de la Paz y Buen Viaje Parish, Surigao City, in the province of Surigao del Norte.

His assignments in the Philippines included co-pastor and ad-interim parish priest at Virgen de la Paz y Buen Viaje Parish from 2000 to 2002; and parish priest at St. Francis Xavier Parish in Pilar, Camotes Island, from 2002 to 2006.

Beginning in 2006, Fr. Ephraim served in several positions aimed at encouraging vocations to the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart. He served from 2006 to 2008 as vocation promoter for Visayas at the MSC Formation Center in Cebu City.

While serving as a parish priest from 2008 to 2013 at Our Mother of Perpetual Help Parish in Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu province, he also served his first term as MSC national vocation director.

He served as rector of the MSC Formation Center from 2014 to 2018; and then a second term as MSC national vocation director, from 2018 to 2020 while based at Our Lady of Fatima Parish in Lapu-Lapu City. He went on to serve as national vocation director/socius while at the MSC Chevalier Novitiate House in Malolos City, Bulacan province, beginning in 2020.

He was assigned to St. Catherine as parochial vicar for a term of three years, effective July 1, 2022.

Fr. Ephraim enjoys singing, playing guitar and tennis.



NADA TERRENAL DURA PARA SIEMPRE

“Enséñanos a contar bien nuestros días”. ¿Existe una oración más sabia y prudente para las personas de todas las edades que este verso del salmo responsorial de hoy? Mientras saboreamos los hermosos pero limitados días del verano, recordamos que nada es eterno. En la primera lectura de hoy, el maestro (Qoheleth) afirma que “todo es vanidad”, aunque el Evangelio de Lucas describe la facilidad con que nuestras posesiones pueden poseernos. La segunda lectura también lo señala: “Piensa en lo de arriba, no en lo de la tierra”. Hoy vemos el problema de la riqueza desde ambos lados: desde el punto de vista de la persona rica que inevitablemente tiene que dejar sus riquezas a otra persona y desde la perspectiva del heredero potencial que está en desacuerdo con su hermano sobre cómo dividir su herencia. El problema está claro; la sabiduría también.

NO PUEDES LLEVARLO CONTIGO

Stephen Covey, en su libro “Los siete hábitos de la gente altamente efectiva”, menciona como segundo hábito: Comenzar con el fin en mente. ¿No es ese el objetivo de nuestras reflexiones bíblicas de hoy? Sabemos que vamos a morir. Sabemos que “no podemos llevarlo con nosotros”. Si alguna vez has tenido que limpiar la casa de una persona fallecida, sabes con qué facilidad los objetos que antes eran un tesoro se convierten en otra carga con la que hay que lidiar. O tal vez haya experimentado lo rápido que la alegría de poseer el último teléfono inteligente se vuelve tan obsoleta como el propio modelo. Entonces, ¿cómo pensamos en todas las cosas que compramos, acumulamos, nos preocupamos por dónde guardarlas y pagamos impuestos por ellas? Y si alguna vez tenemos que mudarnos, ¿que eso no ocurra por que es demasiado trabajo!

RICO EN LO QUE LE IMPORTA A DIOS

Lucas nos pone en el camino correcto cuando afirma que debemos ser “ricos en lo que le importa a Dios”. Ni que decir tiene que no está diciendo que las posesiones en sí mismas sean malas. El salmo de hoy pide a Dios -dos veces- que “nos prospere el trabajo de nuestras manos”. El peligro es que, como dijo un gracioso, “nunca tenemos suficiente de lo que realmente no necesitamos”. ¿Qué es lo que le importa a Dios? ¿Qué es lo contrario de la vanidad? La bondad con los demás, la misericordia, el perdón, la generosidad con los pobres y los necesitados: todo esto permanece más allá de la muerte. Es lo que podemos llevar con nosotros cuando morimos. El gran misterio de todo esto es que Dios nunca es superado en generosidad; cuanto más damos, más tenemos.

El 31 de julio es también la fiesta de Ignacio de Loyola, fundador de la Compañía de Jesús. Él personifica la riqueza en lo que realmente importa. Sus aspiraciones militares y cortesanas se esfumaron tras ser gravemente herido en combate. Su posterior cambio de opinión le llevó a fundar una de las órdenes religiosas más influyentes de la historia de la Iglesia. Si lo contrario de la vanidad es la riqueza que permanece después de la muerte, Ignacio es hoy honrado con toda propiedad.

INFORMACIÓN LITÚRGICA

31 de julio - DECIMOCTAVO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

1 de agosto - San Alfonso María de Ligorio, obispo y doctor de la Iglesia

2 de agosto - *San Eusebio de Vercelli, obispo;*
San Pedro Julián Eymard, presbítero

4 de agosto - San Juan María Vianney, presbítero

5 de agosto - *Dedicación de la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor*

6 de agosto - TRANSFIGURACIÓN DEL SEÑOR

San Alfonso se licenció en derecho civil y canónico a los dieciséis años; dejó una prometedora carrera de abogado para entrar en el sacerdocio; impulsado por la oración, escuchó la voz del Señor: "Deja el mundo y entrégate a mí"; en 1732 fundó la Congregación del Santísimo Redentor (los Redentoristas); murió en 1787. MAGNIFICAT

San Eusebio, primer obispo de Vercelli, una ciudad del norte de Italia; se opuso a la herejía arriana, una falsa enseñanza según la cual Jesús no era realmente divino, lo que causó confusión en la Iglesia durante dos siglos; debido a su oposición, fue exiliado y finalmente regresó a su diócesis; murió en el año 371.

San Pedro en 1856 fundó la Congregación del Santísimo Sacramento, escribió: "Hay que ponerse rápidamente a trabajar para salvar a las almas por la divina Eucaristía, para despertar [a un mundo] adormecido en la apatía adormecida porque no conoce el don de Dios, Jesús, el Emmanuel eucarístico"; murió en 1868. MAGNIFICAT

San Juan María Vianney deseó desde joven ser sacerdote; conocido popularmente como el Cura de Ars; escribió: "Jesucristo, que cuida de todos, no dejaría a sus fieles, en su ilimitada caridad, sin ayuda y consuelo en la hora más trascendental y crítica de sus vidas, y ha instituido, por tanto, un sacramento especial para los enfermos y moribundos. Por medio de este sacramento deben recibir consuelo y ayuda material y espiritual"; murió en 1859.

Basílica de Santa María Mayor la fecha marca la dedicación de la primera basílica mariana de Roma, consagrada a María por el Papa Sixto III hacia el año 435. Se dice que María señaló su elección del emplazamiento de la iglesia con una nevada en agosto.

En la Transfiguración del Señor celebramos una fiesta de la gloria de Dios. Los maravillosos acontecimientos de este día se relatan en los evangelios de Mateo 17:1-2, Marcos 9:1-3 y Lucas 9:28-29: Jesús tomó a Pedro, y a los hermanos Juan y Santiago, y subieron solos a un monte alto para orar. Mientras Jesús oraba, su rostro cambió de aspecto, resplandeció como el sol, y sus vestidos se volvieron blancos como la luz, como ningún batán de la tierra podría blanquearlos.

La transfiguración de Jesús prefigura la transformación en la gloria a la que estamos llamados por nuestra participación en el misterio pascual: la muerte y la resurrección de Jesús. ORDO


