## CHARLESTON, SC & SAVANNAH, GA

### 6 Days - 5 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

**Day 1** Depart from home and travel to your overnight stop in Charlotte, NC where lodging has been arranged at the **Drury Inn University Place** (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 2 After breakfast, check out and travel to Charleston, SC where you will meet your guide for a Historic Charleston Tour. During your tour you will see Charleston City Market, White Point Garden, Rainbow Row, Old Exchange Building, Four Corners of Law, Site of Gadsden Wharf, U.S. Custom House, Ashley Hall, The Battery, College of Charleston and several historic churches including the Circular Congregation Church, St. Michael's Church and the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist. After the tour, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before checking into your hotel.

Day 3 Enjoy breakfast, then head for Boone Hall Plantation & Gardens, founded in 1681 when Englishman Major John Boone came to Charleston and established a lucrative plantation and gracious home on the banks of Wampacheone Creek. The family and descendants of Major Boone were influential in the history of South Carolina, the colonies and the nation. The mansion that exists today which was built in 1936 by Canadian ambassador Thomas Stone. Guided tours of the first floor allow you to see how a Coastal Carolina planter's family lived. From here, explore the formal gardens, grounds and slave cabins located on the estate and enjoy a live performance of "Exploring the Gullah Culture" at the Gullah Theater. There will be time for lunch on your own in Charleston's historic area before departing for an afternoon relaxing harbor cruise to historic Fort Sumter. Upon arrival you will be greeted by National Park Service Rangers, who will provide further details about Fort Sumter and its pivotal role in the American Civil War. On the fort you will find a very informative museum with many historic artifacts and a museum store. After your roughly one-hour visit, you will enjoy a soothing cruise back to your departure point where you will depart for dinner before returning to your hotel for the evening.

Day 4 After breakfast, check out and travel to Johns Island where you will find the Angel Oak Tree. It is considered to be the largest Live Oak Tree east of the Mississippi estimating to be 300 to 400 years old. Continuing south, stop on Wadmalaw Island and the Charleston Tea Garden. Home to Bigelow Teas, you will receive a brief orientation upon arrival, then walk through the factory where television screens describe the tea production process along the way. From here, hop aboard a trolley for a 45-minute tour of the grounds and greenhouse. At the conclusion of the tour, a box lunch has been arranged before heading to the Savannah, GA area where lodging has been arranged at the Drury Plaza Hotel. After checking in, continue to downtown Savannah for a family-style dinner at Paula Deen's The Lady & Sons Restaurant

Day 5 Following breakfast, check out and meet your guide for a 2-hour tour of one of the largest restored National Historic Landmark Districts in the nation. This beautiful city eloquently displays exquisite ironwork, ancient cobblestones, splendid mansions and picturesque cottages. You will see and hear about Factors Walk, Trustees Garden, City Market, and Colonial Cemetery. At the conclusion of the tour, depart for Savannah's Old City Market area for lunch on your own and some window shopping before heading returning to Charlotte, NC where lodging has been arranged at the Drury Inn University Place (pack an ovemight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 6 Following breakfast, check out and depart for home with fond memories of Charleston & Savannah.
