In December, we were not able to do as many Christmas activities as in years past, due to the Covid-19 restrictions. We praise God we were still able to have our children's Christmas program, with 11 children (and 2 youth) involved. Our theme this year was, "Jesus, the Source of our Great Joy." Sister Coco and the children did a great job in exalting the name of our Saviour! As in years past, we were also able to provide food boxes to two needy families just in time for Christmas. What a joy to be able to be a blessing to others!

On December 31st, we had our "Old Year's Night" service. Due to the curfew, we were unable to have a long service or be together at midnight like usual. However, we still had a good service, with two of our men preaching. Bro. Jahmark preached for his first time, on being the salt and the light of the world. It was a wonderful service, with good unity among those who were able to be there.
