SERVICE WINDOW INSTALLED

Your safety is our top priority and so a new service window has been installed at the District office to allow customers to pay their bills and obtain a receipt without having to come inside our building. A large plexiglass screen protects both customers and staff from Covid-19 while a slot allows for transferring of money and documents. Masks will still be required when using the pay window.

SHELTER COVE LIBRARY

Dear Residents and Property Owners -

The Shelter Cove community and the Resort Improvement District were thrilled to celebrate the re-opening of Shelter Cove Road at Mile Post 7.6 on Wednesday, Sept 23rd along with 2nd District Supervisor Estelle Fennell, DPW Director Tom Mattson, RID Directors Michael Schad & David Sommer and representatives from McCullough Construction. During the winter of 2017 a major portion of the Shelter Cove Road failed (at Milepost 7.6) and remained open to only a single lane.

The road closed completely in April 2020 with the start of road re-construction and repair performed by McCullough Construction. With Shelter Cove Road now fully open to two-way traffic, residents and visitors alike now have safer and more efficient access to recreation, business and beach opportunities in the Cove. The District would like to thank the Shelter Cove community, especially the residents who live along the detour routes for their patience during the last three years. The District invites all to come and see the fine work completed by McCullough Construction and to experience the wonder and beauty that is Shelter Cove and the surrounding King Range.

I am pleased to share that Gov. Gavin Newsom and the California Department of Public Health announced last week that outdoor public playgrounds can reopen under specific COVID-19 safety guidelines. According to the guidelines, all people age 2 and older visiting a playground should: Wear a facial covering at all times; Maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance from those outside of their household and keep playground visits to 30 minutes per day when others are present.

In other news, the District is forming a new Parks/Recreation/Greenbelt Working Group to assist District staff in the development of a comprehensive Parks, Recreation and Greenbelt Management Plan. Community members are invited to participate in future working group meetings (meeting date/time & online link to join are found below) to help develop the plan and identify priorities for current and future grant funding and future District expenditures.
