BALTIMORE, ANNAPOLIS, & ST. MICHAELS, MD

4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

Day 1 - Depart from your hometown and travel to Baltimore, arriving in time to enjoy lunch on your own at **Harborplace** where you will also have time to visit the shops. After lunch, meet your guide at the National Aquarium driveway and depart aboard your bus for a **guided tour of the historic highlights of the Monumental City**. See Mt. Vernon Place and the Washington Monument (*Baltimore's first formal tribute to our nation's first president.*) View the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the very first Catholic Cathedral in the United States. Stop at the gravesite of Edgar Allen Poe and hear the story of the mysterious circumstances surrounding his untimely death. After your tour - check into your lodging and prepare for dinner, a delicious **seafood meal at Phillips Harborplace Restaurant**.

Day 2 - Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then travel south of Baltimore to Annapolis. Upon arrival you will meet your **colonial-attired tour guide** who will bring history to life as you stroll through **historic downtown Annapolis and the Maryland State House**. Be inspired with the sights and sounds of the U.S. Naval Academy, home to over 4,000 midshipmen. After lunch on your own in the city dock area, board the **Harbor Queen** for a 40-minuted **narrated cruise on historic Annapolis Harbor** and the banks of the U.S. Naval Academy. Return to the Baltimore area for dinner, followed by a relaxing evening.

Day 3 - After breakfast at your hotel, check out and depart for St. Michaels MD. Upon arrival, spend time exploring this quaint seaside town at your own pace. Afterwards, travel to St. Michaels where you will visit the **Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum**, an interactive museum which houses a collection of Chesapeake Bay artifacts, exhibitions, and vessels. Dinner has been arranged for you at the **Crab Claw**, after which you will check into your hotel for a restful evening.

Day 4 - Following breakfast, check out and depart for a cruise aboard the "**Patriot**". Depart for home after you visit.
