In late 2018, we decided to create a group that can support the vast recreational developments that will further transform the City of Dallas.*

We look forward to implementing green initiatives and historically focused art installations, highlighting other non-profits promoting social change and simply bringing green space to the surrounding workforce. By 2022, we will be a fully active park that supports connecting trails, parks, restaurants and the very people who keep the City of Dallas reaching towards the goal of a completely walkable, world-class destination.







# PHASES OF DEVELOPMENT & COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

## ***Spring 2019: It's My Park Day!***

In April 2019, individuals, community groups, corporate organizations were invited to participate in beautification projects at Stemmons Park to bring awareness to the area and promote inclusion for surrounding businesses to make this park their own.

## ***Late Summer 2019: Park Board Meeting***

By September 2019, we hope to have raised sufficient funding located within the Dallas Parks Foundation Fund to gain approval to purchase additional lighting, new benching and picnic tables, water fountains, trashcans, and Dallas' first Portland Loo to support Stemmons Park as a functioning food truck destination for surrounding living communities and businesses.

## ***Fall 2019: Food Truck Park Activation***

Stemmons Park was granted food truck permittal in January 2019. Pending Park Board approval, Stemmons Park will invite local food trucks to create a consistent schedule based around both work day for surrounding businesses and for weekend recreational use. With added benches and amenities, this will awaken the Oaklawn & Design Districts interest in the parks' existence and pave the way for future projects.

## ***Spring 2020: Urban Farming & Historical Education Initiatives***

After months of consistent use for this once forgotten space, we will begin planning our second phase of development to introduce urban container farming to support local soup kitchens and introduce additional historical elements formerly located in Stemmons Park. We will install Graphic Panels to educate visitors about what this space has meant to Dallas' transportation history.



# INITIAL GIFTING OPPORTUNITIES

## ***Benching***

Standard to benching in all Dallas Park locations, we recommend a total of six to support the park and regular visitors to the space throughout the year.

**\$1,500/bench including the installation & name plaque.**

## ***Tiered Water Fountain***

With three levels of water dispensary, visitors and animals alike will be able to replenish their thirst with the existing water line currently located on the property.

**\$10,000 including installation & name plaque.**

## ***Portland Loo***

As Dallas' first Portland Loos, we will be able to prevent problems commonly experienced with public toilets. The modern kiosk discourages crime with graffiti-proof panels and open grating.

**\$200,000 including installation & name plaque.**

## ***Picnic Tables***

Standard to picnic bench ratios located in many populated food truck areas, we recommend a total of four to support the park

**\$2,000/table including installation and name plaque**

## ***Trash Receptacles***

To support the influx of residents using the park on a consistent basis, we recommend four trash cans installed to be added to the existing pickup schedule

**\$5,000/each including installation and name plaque**

## ***General Maintenance Fund***

To maintain this park and all it's new amenities, we will depend on donors to aid in sponsorships to support the upkeep and maintenance throughout the year.

**\$1,000 for 'Friend of the Park' signage**
