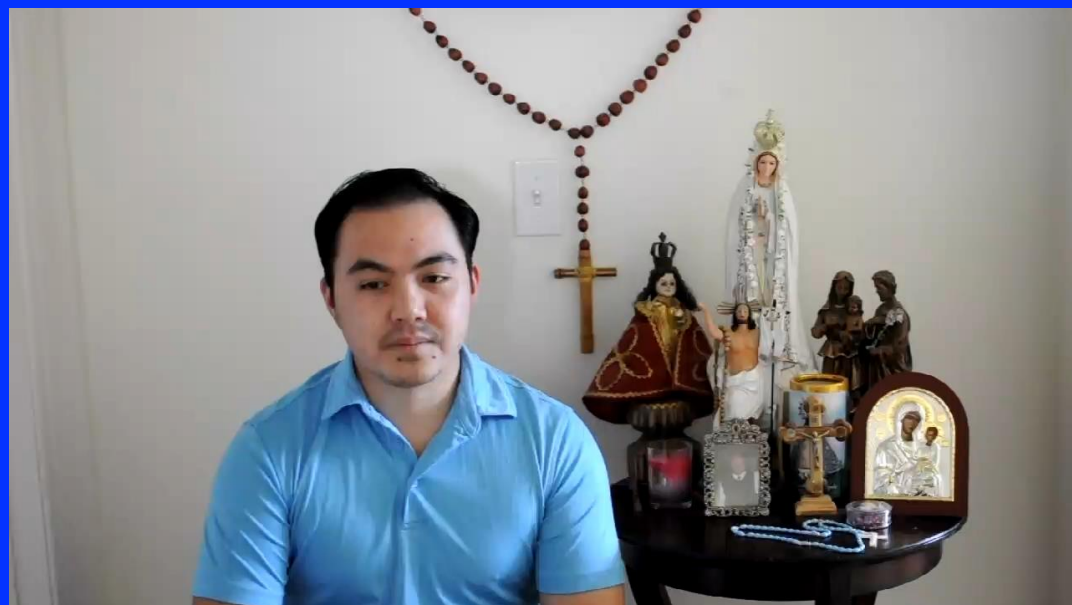

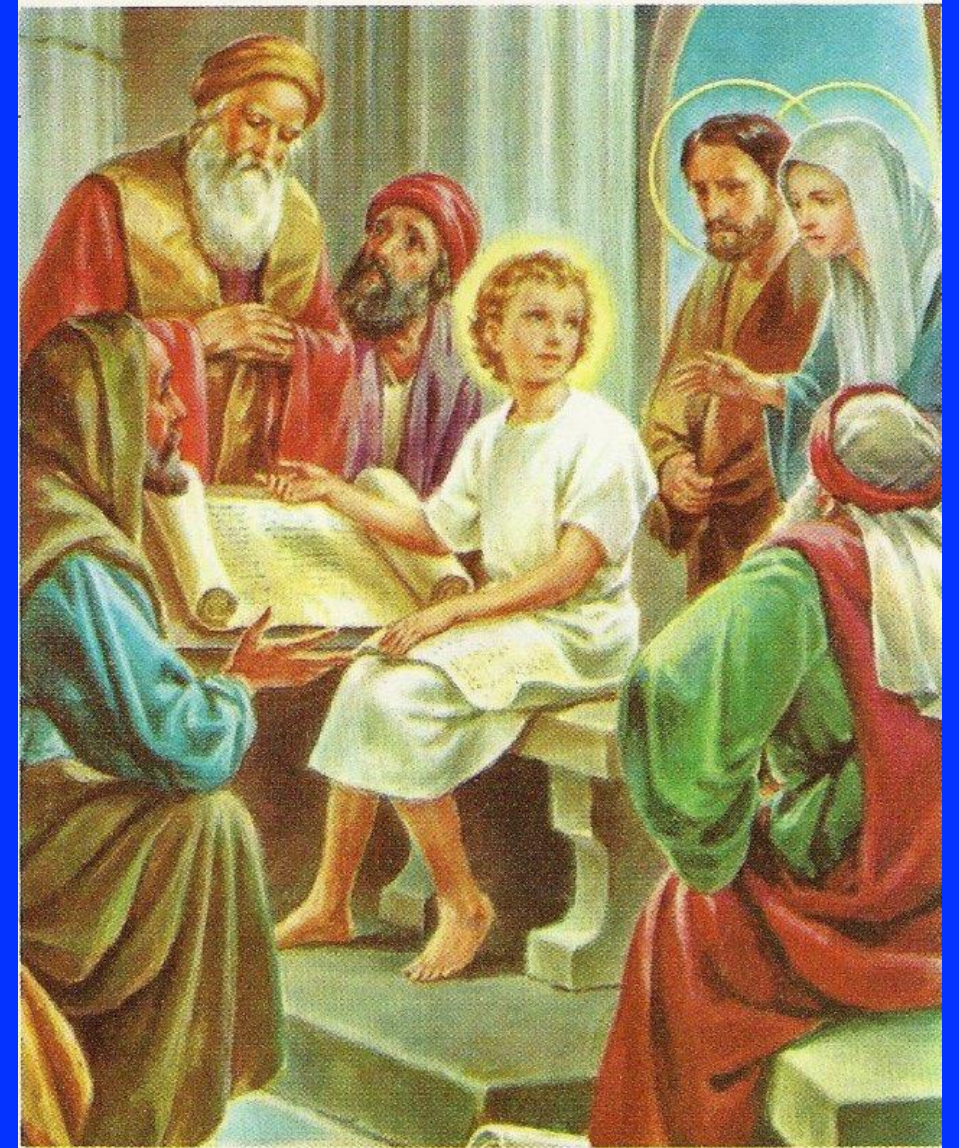
5. Finding the Child Jesus in the Temple

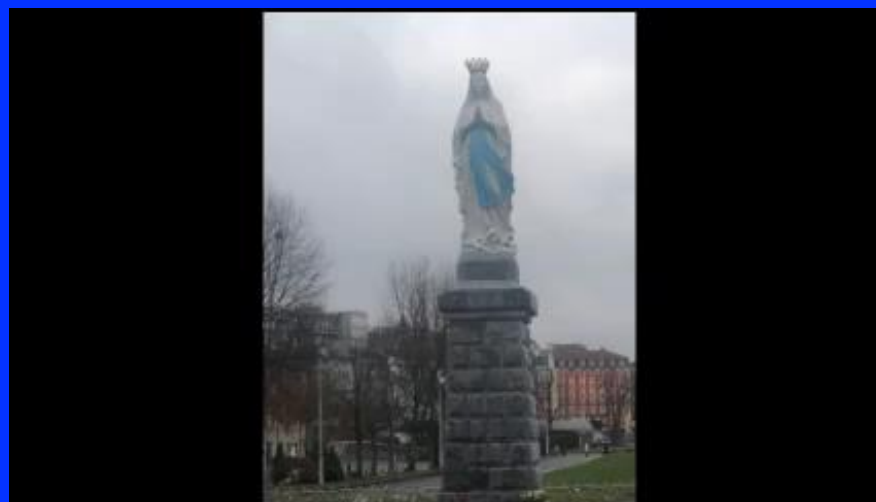
