

By-Law 80-14
By-Law respecting loitering and begging

Pursuant to the authority of Sec. 91.2 of the Municipalities Act, the Village of Blacks Harbour hereby adopts Sec. 91.1 as a Loitering and Begging By-Law, to wit:

1. No person shall loiter unless such person, when required to do so, justifies his reason for doing so.
2. No person shall beg or solicit from door to door or in a public place except as may be authorized by the municipality.
3. Every person who commits an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars and in default of payment is liable to imprisonment in accordance with the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act.
