I THESSALONIANS

Part Forty: "Excellence in Moral Purity, Part 6"

I Thessalonians 4:8

He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit.

Moral Purity is a matter of my <u>respect</u> for <u>God</u>.

Despise means "disrespect, disregard."

Genesis 25:34, 2 Samuel 19:43, Proverbs 1:7

- 1. When you commit acts of moral impurity, it demonstrates that you disregard the <u>value</u> of <u>holiness</u>. He therefore that despiseth
- 2. When you <u>disregard</u> the value of holiness you will <u>commit</u> acts of moral impurity. He therefore that despiseth
- 3. When you commit acts of moral impurity, you are are demonstrating a deep lack of respect and esteem for God.

despiseth not man, but Go;, Psalm 51:4

- 4. The root cause of moral impurity is a weak <u>relationship</u> with God. despiseth not man, but God
- 5. Since moral impurity is the result of a disregard for holiness, it is therefore a direct <u>assault</u> upon the Holy Spirit who indwells **YOU.** who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit.
