### Required Tools for Indentured Apprentices **TELECOMMUNICATIONS TECHNICIAN**

- Tool Box or Bag (Large enough to contain listed tools)
- Tool Pouch and Belt
- 2 Pair Channel Lock Pliers, #420 or equivalent (Grooved, not slip joint type)
- Pliers, 9" (Klein Lineman side-cutting type)
- Hacksaw Frame with Blade Storage
- Claw Hammer (fiberglass or metal handle)
- Screw Drivers - Straight and Phillips assorted sizes
- Tech Driver (with assorted tips)
- 6 Foot Wooden Folding Rule (Klein or Lufkin type **inside reading**)
- Pocket Knife
- Pliers, 6" Long-nose (needle-nose)
- Pliers, 8" Diagonal cutting
- Scratch Awl (solid metal or metal through handle)
- Crescent Wrench, 10" adjustable wrench
- Flashlight (2-cell)
- Torpedo Level, 9" magnetic
- Sheetrock saw
- Tap Wrench (T-handle Type)
- Crimp tool, indenting (Thomas & Betts type)
- Wire strippers – Small wire sizes
- Punch down tool with 66 & 110 blades (employee provides 1<sup>st</sup> set of blades – employer provides thereafter)
- Telecom snips/scissors
- Pick and Spudger (Dental type)
- Pencil
- Keyed Padlock (medium-sized for lockout/tagout)
