I Thessalonians 2:5-6

For neither at any time used we flattering words, as ye know, nor a cloke of covetousness; God is witness: Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor yet of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ.

- 3. Paul's Methods. 5-12.
 - a. Paul's methods were free of phoniness. 5-6.
 - 1) Paul was <u>careful</u> in his presentation.
 - a) His speech. flattering words
 - b) His personality. cloke of covetousness
 - c) His emphasis. nor of men sought we glory
 - 2) Paul was <u>consistent</u> in his purpose.
 - a) His sincerity was constant. neither at any time
 - b) His sincerity was <u>clear</u>. as ye know
 - c) His sincerity was <u>confirmed</u>. *God is witness*
 - 3) Paul was <u>cautious</u> of their perceptions. *when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ*
 - a) He did not want his title to be a <u>distraction</u>.
 - b) He did not want his title to be a burden.
 - c) He did not want to take advantage of his title.
