Swimming Lessons

Ages 3 & Up June 10 – July 31 (7 weeks)

Fee: \$126 The fee includes a QR Swim name tag to put on your child's swim bag.

Tuesdays, Wednesdays, or Thursdays

30 minute lessons between 1:00pm-4:00pm (15 minutes before and after lesson to change & shower—no time to wash and dry hair)

Children need to be potty trained. No open wounds or band-aids allowed in the pool. Absentees are not eligible for refunds or make up lessons. See qrcp.org for details on swimming lesson skills

Learning to swim at Quentin Road is so much fun! With 90° warm water, a variety of pool toys, slides, small classes and happy instructors, your child will love the water!

The Quentin Road Instructors use a skill based program referencing the YMCA and the American Red Cross as guidelines for our swimming lessons. Class size is limited to 4 to 1 for Preschool, and 6 to 1 for Kindergarten and up. We have a minimum of 2 Lifeguard Certified Instructors and an additional Lifeguard poolside at each lesson. If their swim lesson is during their scheduled camp day, they will be accompanied to and from the pool area.

The Quentin Road Summer Camp is offering an Intramural Swim Team for all children entering 2nd grade and up. We will have fun with games, competitions, prizes, workouts and a swim meet. Although this is a learning program, your child should already know how to do the Front Crawl, Back Crawl, Breast Stroke, and the Elementary Back Stroke and be able to swim two lengths of each stroke before joining. The Quentin Road Instructors use a comprehensive swim instruction program as the guidelines for our Swim Team.

Our Swim Team is a multifaceted intramural program. We strive to build well-rounded athletes. The swim team will work on stroke refinement, breathing techniques, quick starts and turns, and other ways to improve race times.

We have a minimum of 2 Certified Lifeguards at each swim team session. If their swim team session is during their scheduled camp day, they will be accompanied to and from the pool area.


