I kindly dare anyone to expose a much better significant and older selfie than mine from year 1982.

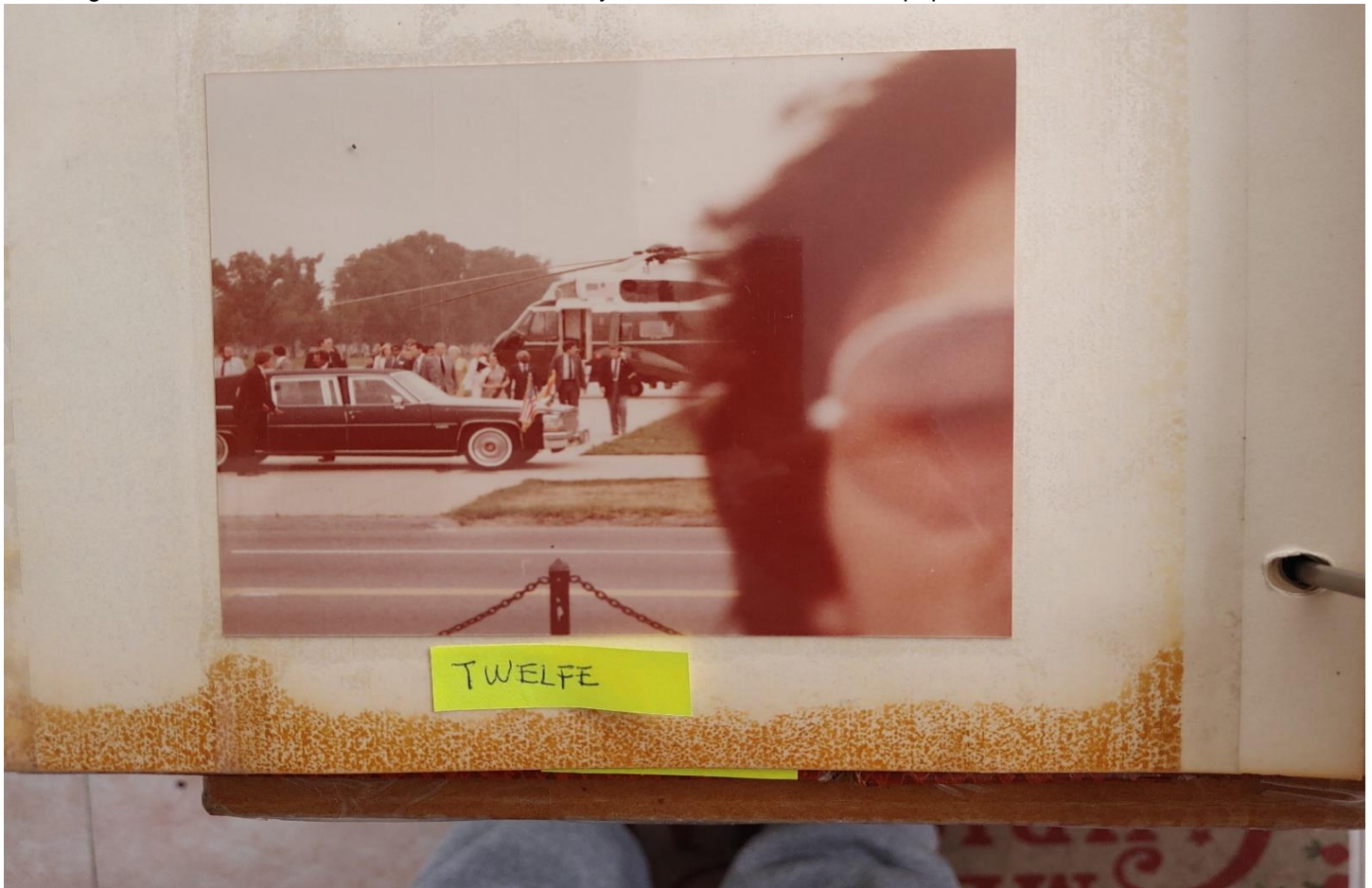
