MONSTER MUNCH SNACK MIX

- 8 cups popcorn
- 3 cups pretzels
- 2 cups white chocolate
- 1 cup m & m candy
- orange candy melts melted
- purple candy melts melted
- candy eyeballs
- ½ cup candy corn
- sprinkles Halloween colors



- Line a baking sheet with parchment/wax paper, and spread popcorn and pretzels evenly on baking sheet
- Melt white chocolate according to package directions, and use spoon to drizzle evenly over cereal and popcorn
- Stir mixture to make sure it's evenly coated
- Drop in m & m candy
- Melt candy coating according to package directions, and drizzle the melted candy melts over the mixture and finish with topping it with the eyeballs and candy corn
- Allow chocolate to set for about 30 minutes before serving. Store in fridge.
