I THESSALONIANS

Part Forty-Four: "Excellence in Brotherly Love, Part 3"

I Thessalonians 4:12 That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing.

Review:

- 1. Impulse: the church of Thessalonica demonstrated that they had had a desire to learn how to love. 9.
- 2. Improvement: Paul instructs them in a stronger quality of love. 10-11.

 Three Important Steps to Improving the Quality of Your Love
 - 1) Control your spirit. study to be quiet
 - 2) Focus your thoughts. do your own business
 - 3) Operate in self-dependence. work with your own hands
- 3. Impact: as they strengthen their <u>love</u> they will strengthen their <u>ministry</u>. 12.

How Does A Self-Dependent Love Strengthen the Ministry?

- a. Self-dependent love gives you a solid <u>testimony</u> and <u>reputation</u>. That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without
 - 1) The church has the reputation of paying its <u>bills</u>.
 - 2) The church has the testimony of being givers, not <u>takers</u>.
 - 3) The church has the testimony of being <u>blessed</u> and <u>provided</u> for by God.
- b. Self-dependent love enables the church to increase its <u>ministry</u>. *and that ye may have lack of nothing*.
 - 1) Because the people themselves will not fail financially.
 - 2) Because the church will have sufficient <u>resources</u>.
