JUMPER CLASSES

Petite Jumper—Fences to be set at .60m (2’)

Hopeful Jumper—Fences to be set at .70m (2’3”)

Novice Jumper—Fences to be set at .80m (2’6”)

Intermediate Jumper—Fences to be set at .90 (2’9”)

Level 2 Jumper—Fences to be set at .95m (3’)

Level 3 Jumper—Fences to be set at 1.00m (3’3”)

Level 4 Jumper—Fences to be set at 1.10m (3’6”)

EQUITATION CLASSES

SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1st of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3’ that must include two changes of direction, a combination and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase will count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Adult Medal. After a rider is qualified for the finals, he may not compete in this class. Rider must be a member of SWVHJA.

SWVHJA Adult Equitation on the Flat Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-18 may be used. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat. Riders must stay within their age group if class split by age.

SWVHJA Adult Medal Class Same specs as the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter Division at the same horse show. Rider must be a member of SWVHJA.

SWVHJA/VHSA Junior Equitation on the Flat Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-18 may be used. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Adult Equitation on the Flat. Will be split by age(15—17 & 14 and Under). Riders must stay within their age group.

Sweet Briar College Medal Open to juniors and amateurs. To be shown over a course of no less than six jumps set at 2’9”. Course must include two changes of direction, and may contain an in and out. The judge will then have the option of testing the top four riders. Tests 1-10 may be used. The same horse must be used in both phases. Three competitors must complete the course for points to count. Riders may not have shown in a 3’6” or higher equitation medal class, and may not jump higher than 2’9” at the same show. This class may be combined with other classes with similar specifications. This class is not recognized or sanctioned by SWVHJA. Finals will be held at the Sweet Briar College Winter Horse Show in December. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points, or be in the top 15 point earners for the year. Riders may continue to compete throughout the year.

To: All Riders, Trainers, Owners and Grooms

Upholding the welfare of the horses exhibited here is of primary concern to our management team. We require that all horses be treated with the kindness, respect and compassion they deserve. They should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, and their agents, must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of horses owned and/or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose.

We will provide for the continuous well being of the horses by vigorously enforcing the rules of USEF, which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that Article 302, which defines the USEF’s policy of Cruelty and Abuse, Article 806, which pertains to Poling, and Article 320, which pertains to the Use of Whips, will be strictly enforced. No excessive use of whips or poling will be tolerated. Violators are subject under the above rules to elimination from the competition.

Entries:

- Six ribbons will be awarded in each class.
- Three entries, unless otherwise stated, are necessary to fill a class.
- Entry forms must be filled out completely, including all classes or divisions entered, signatures and organization or membership numbers before numbers can be issued.
- A negative **Coggins** within 12 months of the show is required and must be presented to Show Secretary or faxed with entry.

AN OPEN CHECK IS REQUIRED BEFORE NUMBERS CAN BE PICKED UP.

- Pre-Entry - Must be received by 3PM the Friday before the show.
- Entries received after 3PM the Friday before the show will be charged a \$10.00 office fee.
- No phone entries. All entries must be received by 3:00 PM, Friday, prior to the show.
- Anyone with a confirmed overnight stall reservation, must arrive before 6:00 PM.

\$15.00 per Jumper Class and Equitation Flat Class

\$20.00 per Eq./Medal: SWVHJA or SBC

\$35.00 per Oct. 15th SBC Medal Finals

\$30.00 - Non-Showing Horse Fee

Office Fee - \$10.00 (**only applied to entries received after 3PM Friday**)

Returned Check fee \$30.00

Stalls: Cost is \$40.00 per night / \$30.00 per day. Initial bedding is provided (A limited number available and reservation required.)

SCHOOLING / HELMETS / DOGS

All riders must sign a waiver or entry form before schooling or riding on the grounds. All schooling is at your own risk.

The ring will be open for schooling from 7– 8 AM.

Schooling the night before the show will be allowed from 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM.

Helmet Rule: Sweet Briar College follows the rules of USEF. **All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI helmets at all times while mounted on the show grounds.** No helmet can protect the wearer against all foreseeable injuries. See Article 318.

All **dogs** must be on leashes while on the show grounds.

Release and Waiver of Liability

I am aware that during my participation and attendance at the Sweet Briar College Horse Show and related serves and activities, Sweet Briar College and its agents, employees and associates ("Sponsor"), will be providing various facilities and arrangements for the Show, and that certain risks and dangers may arise, including but not limited to hazards inherent in the sport(s) in which I will be training preparing or competing; negligent or other careless acts and omissions by other participants, spectators and the Sponsor; and hazardous or dangerous conditions of the facilities and grounds used as part of the horse shows.

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry by the Sponsor and the right granted to me to participate in and attend the Show and related activities, I do hereby assume all of the above risks, and agree that, in the event of any injury to me as a result of an accident which occurs during my involvement and participation in the show, my recovery against the Sponsor, shall be limited to a claim for medical expenses incurred as a result of the injury, and only to the extent that such medical expenses are not otherwise covered or paid by my insurance coverage, medical or otherwise. Furthermore, for this consideration, I agree to present any claim for personal injury to the Sponsor within six (6) months from the date of injury: if I fail to do so, I agree that I will have waived any and all rights I have to recover against the Sponsor for said injury.

Additionally, in consideration and acceptance of my entry by the Sponsor and the right to participate in and attend the Show and related activities, I consent to receive any and all emergency medical treatment as may be deemed appropriate under the existing circumstances as then determined by the Sponsor or its agents. I also grant Sweet Briar College permission to use my likeness, voice, and words in television, radio, film, or in any form to promote activities at Sweet Briar College. I also understand that there will be no refunds.

(Following portion pertains only to parents or guardian of a participant who is 17 years of age or younger.)

I have read and consent to the above limitations on recovery and agree on my and my child's behalf that any recovery against the Sponsor for injury arising as a result of an accident which occurs during my child's involvement and participation in the show, should said injury occur due to the negligence of the Sponsor, shall be limited to a claim for medical expenses incurred as a result of said injury, and only to the extent that such medical expenses are not otherwise covered or paid by my or my child's insurance coverage, medical or otherwise. Furthermore, for this consideration, I agree to present any claim for personal injury to my child to the Sponsor within six (6) months from the date of injury; if I or my child fail to do so, I agree that I will have waived any and all right I have to recover against the Sponsor for said injury.

Directions:

From Charlottesville – On Route 29S, take the Madison Heights/Sweet Briar College exit. Go two miles past the college entrance. Turn right just before the Best Bet/Citgo service station onto Rt. 663/Smokey Hollow Rd. Go about one mile, bearing right at the fork. At the bottom of a fairly steep hill you will see a sign for the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Turn right.

From Lynchburg – On Route 29N Business go about ten miles past the James River to Faulconerville. After the Excel Station (on right), get in the left lane. Turn left at the Best Bet/Citgo station, driving across Route 29S onto Route 663/Smokey Hollow Road. Go about one mile, bearing right at the fork. At the bottom of a fairly steep hill you will see a sign for the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Turn right.

From South of Lynchburg - On Route 29 N just past the Lynchburg airport, exit onto 460 East towards Appomattox. Take exit for 29 N Bypass (Charlottesville/Amherst). Exit at Route 29 Business/Amherst/Sweet Briar College. At the end of the exit turn left to go toward Sweet Briar College/Madison Heights. Go two miles past the college entrance. Turn right just before the Best Bet/Citgo service station onto Rt. 663/Smokey Hollow Rd. Go about one mile, bearing right at the fork. At the bottom of a fairly steep hill you will see a sign for the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Turn right.

Parking:

- 1) Please watch for and follow parking signs.
- 2) Large trailers and horse vans may turn around in the parking area behind the indoor arena.
- 3) Large trailers and horse vans may park on the East side of the Riding Center or in the parking lot behind the indoor arena.
- 4) To keep the road clear, parking is restricted to the south side of the road, which is the right side of the road as you enter the facility.
