What is the SCA Summer Bridge Program?

- It is a two week enrichment program designed to meet the individual learning needs of students in English Language Arts and Mathematics for TK-8th grade.
- Lessons will be differentiated to “Bridge the Gap” and target student and class identified goal areas.



Are There Safety Protocols In Place?



- Students stay with their grade level class and do not mix with other classes (ex 3rd grade stays in the third grade classroom)
- Current school safety protocols are still in place:
 - break and recess only with current class.
 - student school drop off and pick up procedures stay the same.
- All protocols and procedures stay the same from SCA School Reopening Plan.
- Mask is required at this time, but SCA uniform is NOT required for summer school.

How Does the Program Work?

- Students first take an IXL diagnostic assessment for Math and ELA.
- Individual and grade level goals are identified from the student assessment data.
- Summer school teachers create targeted lessons around identified student and class goal areas.

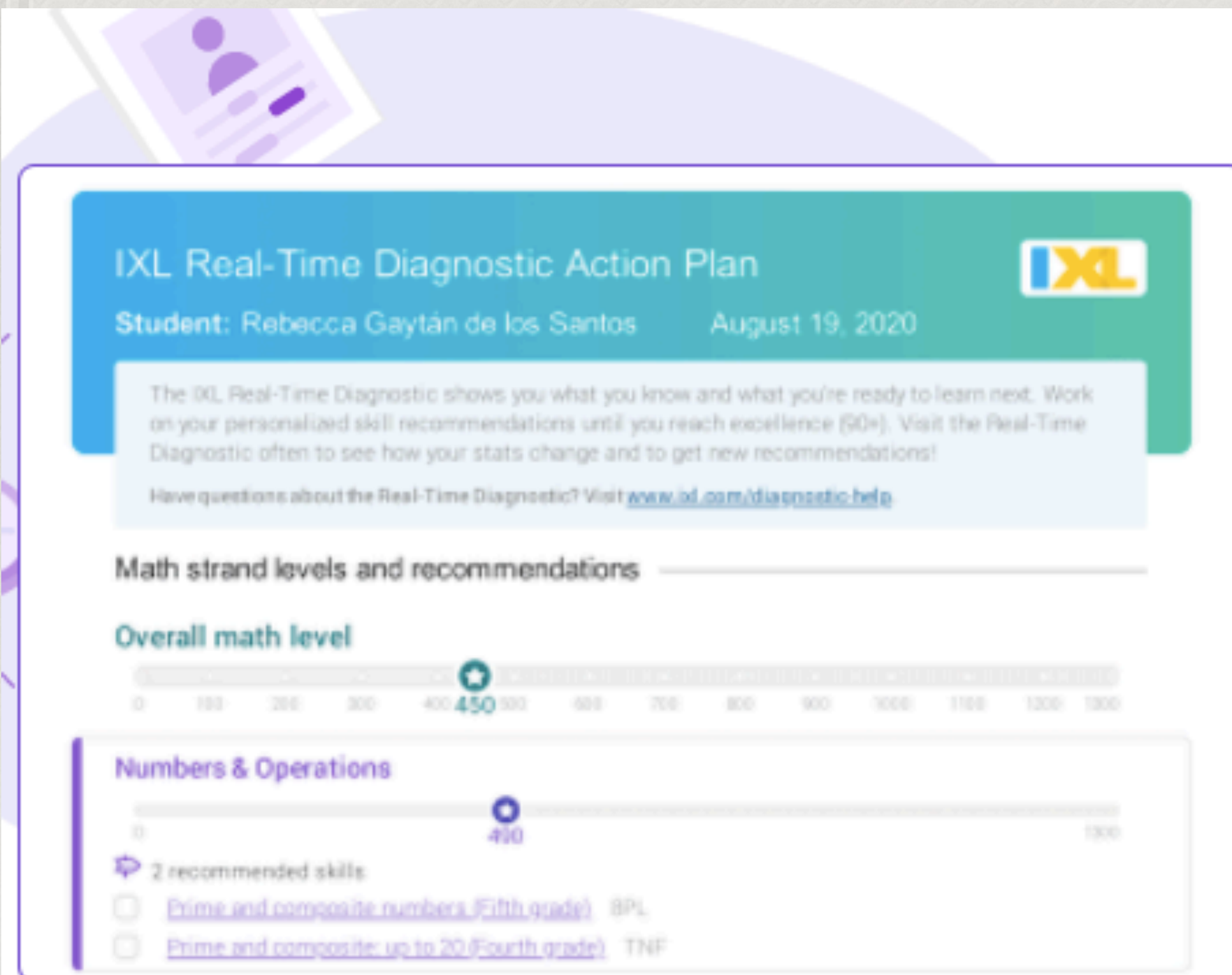
