TO: Stanley R. Hackett, Constable of the Town of Limerick: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF LIMERICK: You are hereby notified that a Regional School Unit No. 57 referendum election will be held at the Limerick Municipal Building, 55 Washington Street in the Town of Limerick on Tuesday, June 9, 2026 for the purpose of determining the following question:

Question 1: Do you favor authorizing the School Board of Regional School Unit No. 57 (the "RSU") to issue bonds and other evidences of indebtedness in the name of the RSU in an amount not to exceed **\$1,160,531** through the State of Maine's zero percent interest rate/loan forgiveness School Revolving Renovation Fund (SRRF) Program for structural roof improvements at Alfred Elementary School (the "Project")?

SRRF Program Funding. The Project costs (up to **\$1,160,531**) have been approved for funding through Maine's SRRF Program. Of this amount, the RSU will receive 40.97% (up to **\$475,470**) that will be forgiven, and 59.03% (up to **\$685,061**) that the RSU will repay at zero percent interest (0%) over a term of ten years.

















The polls must be opened at 8:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M.
