MATTHEW 5:10-12

"Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

It is interesting that the last Beatitude is the one that is most developed, and it focuses on being persecuted for the sake of Christ. It is countercultural. Jesus is teaching that you are blessed by God when you suffer because of the righteous life you live for God's glory. You are blessed when the world reviles you. You are blessed when the world excludes you. You are blessed when the world insults you and considers you as evil. Jesus even claims that experiencing opposition from the world provides sufficient grounds for his disciples to rejoice and be glad. It provides his followers assurance of eternal rewards from the Heavenly Father.

A TRUE DISCIPLE WILL BE REJECTED BY THE WORLD. IN JOHN 15, AFTER COMMANDING HIS DISCIPLES TO LOVE EACH OTHER, JESUS INFORMS THEM THAT THEY WILL LIKELY NOT BE LOVED BY THE WORLD. IN JOHN 15:18–19, JESUS SAID, "IF THE WORLD HATES YOU, KEEP IN MIND THAT IT HATED ME FIRST. IF YOU BELONGED TO THE WORLD, IT WOULD LOVE YOU AS ITS OWN. AS IT IS, YOU DO NOT BELONG TO THE WORLD, BUT I HAVE CHOSEN YOU OUT OF THE WORLD. THIS IS WHY THE WORLD HATES YOU."

WE SHOULD NOT BE SURPRISED WHEN THE WORLD OPPOSES OUR CHRISTIAN CONVICTIONS AND VALUES. THE CHRISTIAN FAITH WILL NEVER BE MAINSTREAM; AT LEAST BEFORE THE LORD JESUS RETURNS AND ESTABLISHES HIS PERFECT KINGDOM. AS JESUS SAID, THE WORLD FIRST HATED HIM. IF WE REMAIN STRONG IN OUR FAITH BY REFUSING TO COMPROMISE IN OUR BELIEF IN GOD'S WORD AND IN OUR DEVOTION TO LIVE FAITHFULLY BEFORE THE LORD, WE WILL EXPERIENCE REJECTION. HERE IN THE U.S., WE MAY NOT EXPERIENCE THE SAME DEGREE OF HOSTILITY AND PERSECUTION AS CHRISTIANS DO IN OTHER PARTS OF THE WORLD, BUT IF WE REMAIN FAITHFUL TO JESUS, WE WILL EXPERIENCE SOME DEGREE OF REJECTION. WE SHOULD BE PRAYING EACH DAY FOR THOSE CHRISTIANS WHO FACE SEVERE PERSECUTION IN OTHER COUNTRIES, BUT WE SHOULD ALSO BE PREPARING OURSELVES, BY THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, TO WITHSTAND WHATEVER OPPOSITION COMES OUR WAY.

OF COURSE, WE ARE NOT TO SEEK TO BE HATED. SADLY, SOME CHRISTIANS LOOK FOR CONFLICT AND ARE NEEDLESSLY OFFENSIVE. WE ARE TO BE PEACEMAKERS (MATT. 5:9). WE ARE TO BUILD A GOOD REPUTATION WITH OUTSIDERS (1 THESS. 4:12, Col. 4:5-6). But we also know that the Gospel is folly to those who are perishing (1 Cor. 1:18). So, above all, we must live faithfully before the Lord.
