

**Saint Paul Miki and Companions**, he was a Japanese Jesuit scholastic, and his twenty-five companions were crucified at Nagasaki, among them the Mexican, Felipe de Jesus, first martyr from the Americas to be beatified; protomartyrs of the Far East (canonized in 1862 by Pope Pius IX). ORDO

**Saint Jerome Emiliani** in the Church's art, he is with a ball and chain with which he was fettered as a prisoner of war in Italy in 1508. From the dungeon he asked Mary for help, and he escaped soon after. He eventually returned to his native Venice, where he was a helper and father to orphans and abandoned children; he died in 1537.

**Saint Josephine Bakhita** at the age of nine, she was kidnapped from her home in Sudan, force-marched for eight days, and sold into slavery, she was cruelly treated. Eventually with a kind Italian family, she made it to Italy, where she embraced the faith; she died in 1947 and was canonized in 2000.

**Saint Scholastica** twin sister of St. Benedict, she died in 543, eventually interred in the same grave with her brother. St Gregory the Great wrote, "*so death did not separate the bodies of these two, whose minds had ever been united in the Lord*".

**TODAY'S READINGS**

**First Reading** — If you share your food with the hungry, provide housing for the homeless, then light shall break forth upon you (Isaiah 58:7-10).

**Psalm** — One who is just is a model for the righteous (Psalm 112).

**Second Reading** — My message to you, says Paul, was not clever words of wisdom but the proclamation of Christ crucified (1 Corinthians 2:1-5).

**Gospel** — You are the salt of the earth, the light of the world (Matthew 5:13-16).

**Brothers and Sisters,**

On this 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time our readings give us much to think about. We are all called to be salt of the earth and light of the world. Life isn't about "me" and my wants. Life is about noticing the vulnerable people around us and sharing our time and energy to support them. We are called to be the voice for those who do not find the justice that they need to live in dignity and peace.

Today's 1st reading from Isaiah reminds us that our Christian focus should be on those in need, to the homeless, the naked and the hungry. Sheltering, clothing and feeding the poor has its origin in God's covenant with Israel. He freed Israel from bondage. In response to God's gratuitous love, the people were to share their bread with the hungry, clothe the naked and shelter the homeless. A community that lives in a right relationship with God is a shining light that dispels darkness, a theme that resounds in today's gospel. St. Paul in our second reading contrasts God's wisdom with human wisdom. The movie, "The Song of Bernadette" which gives us the story of Lourdes and its miracles, begins with the words: "For him who does not believe in God, no explanation is possible; for him who believes in God no explanation is necessary." These words aptly describe the lesson to be drawn from today's reading. The source of human wisdom is the Spirit not Paul's wisdom or eloquence. Paul makes it clear that the power and wisdom of God and God's word are not to be judged by human standards.

In today's gospel, Matthew uses salt to illustrate what happens when a disciple's fervor for the Word of God go flat. Of all the seasonings, *salt* is the most ordinary. Of all the necessities, *light* is one of the most basic. Jesus calls us to be salt and light, to be common elements which give flavor to life, and help people find their way. Both salt and light, are symbols preserved through the centuries that reveal the many dimensions of God's relationship with the human race. In the ancient world salt was used as a means to preserve foods, for purification of people, conquered lands, sacrifices and a sign of hospitality. People who dined together were united in a sacred bond of friendship through the shared sign of salt. Salt was as a sign of the covenant bond that existed between Yahweh (God) and the people. It was referred to as a "covenant made in salt" (2Chr. 13:5); this relationship with Yahweh is permanent and not to be broken. If disciples become flat like salt without flavor and take God for granted, they will be useless in service to God. Disciples are to become the salt of the earth.

Light is the primary symbol in our church. We are all Disciples, called to be a light to the nations. By example we are to reveal God to the world. We as disciples are to be the beacon on the hill, the city that lights up the world. We are salt and light because Jesus called us and all are to respond. Final thought: If we are truly the salt of the earth and the light of the world, people should be able to see Jesus alive and active in us. Do they?



### COMUNIDAD DE LUZ

Las lecturas de hoy de Isaías y Mateo evocan la poderosa metáfora de la luz como imagen de la comunidad reunida por Dios. Jesús habla de sus seguidores como "luz del mundo": no son la fuente de luz, sino un espejo que refleja el resplandor de Dios. Esta luz no llama la atención sobre sí misma, sino que permite revelar y celebrar la belleza y exponer y sanar el pecado. La luz de esta comunidad no es principalmente para sí misma, sino que cumple su propósito cuando brilla sobre el mundo. La luz que nosotros, la Iglesia, aportamos a nuestro mundo puede quedar oculta por "matorrales" a veces impuestos por otros y a veces de nuestra propia cosecha. Nuestras luces pueden parpadear y morir bajo el estrés. ¿Qué puede sostener el brillo de nuestra pequeña luz? Nuestras prácticas continuas de oración comunitaria, discernimiento y acción permiten a Dios iluminar nuestra Iglesia, día a día.

### APRENDER A SER IGLESIA

Tras el pasaje de Mateo de la semana pasada con las Bienaventuranzas, hoy continuamos el Sermón de la Montaña de Jesús con sus imágenes de la sal, la luz y una ciudad. Jesús pasa de describir la identidad básica de la comunidad que ha reunido a considerar su impacto en el mundo. Quería que su comunidad no sólo reivindicara su identidad, sino que la viviera. Quería que su comunidad caminara con él, que aprendiera plenamente lo que esto podía significar.

Para nosotros, ser sal para los demás puede significar comprometernos y enriquecer la vida de nuestros vecinos. Ser luz puede significar iluminar y abordar los sistemas del mundo que sostienen los pecados sociales de la violencia, el racismo y las grandes desigualdades de riqueza y oportunidades. Ser una ciudad elevada puede significar mantener un alto nivel de transparencia, respeto y cuidado mutuo. Como los primeros seguidores de Jesús, se nos invita a recorrer el difícil y gozoso camino de aprender y reaprender a ser Iglesia.

### MINISTERIO EN FORMA DE CRUZ

San Pablo, en el pasaje de hoy de la primera epístola a los Corintios, admite que no es un vendedor. No vino a Corinto con un discurso de venta, con una retórica hábil y una sabiduría mundana. Pablo dice que simplemente vino a hablar de Cristo crucificado. Para Pablo, la cruz es la principal revelación de Dios, y toda la vida de seguimiento de Cristo está marcada por ella. Pablo describe este ministerio en forma de cruz por cómo lo predicó al principio: con humildad y temor. Era un mensajero que parecía débil según las normas de la sociedad, para que el Espíritu pudiera llegar a sus oyentes.

Puede que conozcamos o hayamos leído sobre quienes hablaron o vivieron con una presencia en forma de cruz. Tal vez un misionero que sirvió humildemente a una comunidad mientras predicaba a Cristo. O un grupo de manifestantes contra la injusticia, que se enfrentaron a la resistencia violenta con dignidad y persistencia. Abren un espacio para que el Espíritu transforme los corazones. Pablo sugiere que hacernos vulnerables hace posible el amor.

**San Pablo Miki y Compañeros**, fue un escolástico jesuita japonés, y sus veinticinco compañeros fueron crucificados en Nagasaki, entre ellos el mexicano Felipe de Jesús, primer mártir de América beatificado; protomártires del Extremo Oriente (canonizado en 1862 por el Papa Pío IX). ORDO

**San Jerónimo Emiliani** en el arte de la Iglesia, está con una bola y una cadena con las que fue encadenado como prisionero de guerra en Italia en 1508. Desde el calabozo pidió ayuda a María, y escapó poco después. Finalmente regresó a su Venecia natal, donde fue ayudante y padre de huérfanos y niños abandonados; murió en 1537.

**Santa Josefina Bakhita** a la edad de nueve años, fue secuestrada de su casa en Sudán, llevada a la fuerza durante ocho días y vendida como esclava, fue cruelmente tratada. Finalmente, una familia italiana la acogió y llegó a Italia, donde abrazó la fe. Murió en 1947 y fue canonizada en 2000.

**Santa Escolástica**, hermana gemela de San Benito, murió en 543 y fue enterrada en la misma tumba que su hermano. San Gregorio Magno escribió: "Así la muerte no separó los cuerpos de estos dos, cuyas mentes habían estado siempre unidas en el Señor".

**Bienaventurada Virgen María de Lourdes**

El 11 de febrero de 1858, una Hermosa mujer se apareció a la vidente Bernadette Soubirous en una remota gruta de piedra a las afueras de Lourdes, Francia. Cuando le preguntó su nombre, la Virgen María respondió: "Soy la Inmaculada Concepción". En el lugar donde pidió una capilla, brotó un manantial. "El manantial que María señaló a Bernadette en Lourdes es el humilde signo de esta realidad espiritual. De su corazón creyente, de su corazón materno, brota el agua viva que purifica y cura". -Papa Benedicto XVI



En 1992, el Papa Juan Pablo II designó el 11 de febrero como Jornada Mundial del Enfermo, "un tiempo especial de oración y de compartir,

de ofrecer el propio sufrimiento por el bien de la Iglesia y de recordarnos que debemos ver en el hermano enfermo el rostro de Cristo que, sufriendo, muriendo y resucitando, logró la salvación de la humanidad".
