

Residential Collection Information

Arrangement to collect and dispose of LARGE ITEMS can be made by calling our office. The cost is \$25.00 per large item and payment must be received in our office before service will be scheduled on your normal service day.

Large items include, but are not limited to:

- One household furniture item such as a chair, couch, mattress, table, etc. OR
- One appliance such as stove, hot water tank, microwave, refrigerator, air conditioner, de-humidifier, and freezer. Any appliances that contained or once contained HFC's or CFC's (commonly known as Freon) must be certified that those chemicals have been removed to be eligible for collection. OR
- One bundle of carpet or linoleum that is dry, cut into lengths of six feet or less, rolled, and securely tied. OR
- One approved container, bag, boxed (dry), or bundled item consisting of building materials that is securely bundled not exceeding 50 pounds as long as the item(s) are not listed in the "unacceptable items" list below.

The following items are deemed "Unacceptable" and will not be collected and/or left at your curb after service.

Unacceptable Items Include but may not be limited to:

- Any item(s) containing chemicals or liquids such as gasoline, oil, antifreeze, unsolidified paint, or other hazardous liquids.
- Medical or special waste.
- Yard waste such as leaves, brush, grass, branches, hay, straw, or garden and plant waste.
- Flammables and explosives.
- Tires or other vehicle parts and/or components.
- Burning Barrels full of cold or hot ashes
- Appliances that contain or once contained HFC's or CFC's (commonly referred to as FREON) without the proper extraction certification.
- Wet carpeting.
- Animal or Human waste or by-products.
- Any other item that cannot be safely lifted by one person or disposed of in a safe manner.
- Other items deemed as un-safe or illegal.
