Masked men come and drive the students away. So we just pray that things will be calm by the time school is to resume in the fall. Things in Buea remain peaceful and we pray it will remain that way.

We held our first baptism service on the Sunday before Easter. (Pictures on the next page) We baptized 4 people and we have another who will be getting baptized soon. One young man named Boris was baptized and has a strong desire to serve God. He has already started helping to lead music. He really likes music, and is doing very well. It is amazing to see God working in his life and see his desire to serve.

The girls recently enjoyed some horseback riding while we were in Bamenda visiting with the other missionaries. On the way back to Buea the fuel pump went out in our car, and we had to stop and get it fixed. We were able to get back on the road and make it home safely late that night. But the car started having problems a few days later, so I have been working on it again. The girls also have several close friends who get to come and play regularly. They are also finishing up this year of school, and looking forward to a break. Sarah also is looking forward to a small break in a very busy schedule.

We have currently raised about \$1500 toward the building we are looking at buying. (Pictures on next page) We still need about \$23000 to be able to purchase it. It is still up for sale, so we are praying that if God wants us to have it, He will provide for us to get it.
