Dear Padre,

Aren't we discriminating against other Christians when we don't celebrate the Eucharist with them?

You have to keep the Church's intentions in mind: Are we excluding to make people feel left out, or are we excluding to uphold the dignity and sanctity of the Eucharist?

Everyone is welcome to celebrate the Eucharist—there's only one part they can't participate in. That might sound like a cop-out, but Catholics believe that the Eucharist is the actual Body and Blood of Christ. For it to be true Communion, everyone who receives it must believe the same thing about it.



In its Guidelines for the Reception of Communion, the United States
Conference of Catholic
Bishops says, "Because
Catholics believe that
the celebration of the
Eucharist is a sign
of the reality of the
oneness of faith, life,
and worship, members
of those churches with
whom we are not yet fully
united are ordinarily

not admitted to Holy Communion. Eucharistic sharing in exceptional circumstances by other Christians requires permission" as outlined in canon law. "All who are not receiving Holy Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another" (*GRC*).



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension of Our Lord Parish,

Mass Registration

Our Mass Registration is going well. Thank you to those who continue to use the pre-registration process! We will continue to have the entire month open as we move into October. October Masses opened this past Thursday, October 1st at 10am.

As attendance continues to grow and the capacity numbers reach limits, some of our neighboring parishes are starting to use two registration lines, one for those who pre-registered and another for those who walk-in. Those who walk-in would wait for a seat if capacity numbers allow for it. Our goal is to not to have two lines. However, we need everyone to pre-register by going to the parish website or by calling the office during office hours on Monday-Friday 9am-2pm. **If you notice that the capacity number has reached its limit for a particular Mass time, that means seating is full and another Mass time can then be selected.** A reminder that pre-registration cuts off one-hour before any Mass. Many neighboring parishes cut registration off a day or two ahead of time. We strive to make this as easy as possible for our parishioners by allowing up to one hour before each Mass time.

Background on Today's Gospel Reading

In today's Gospel, Jesus once again speaks to the priests and elders with a parable. In this parable, the landowner leases his vineyard to tenants and sends his servants to collect the portion of the harvest that the tenants owe to him. Several times the servants are sent to collect payment, and each time they are beaten and killed by the tenants. Finally, the landowner sends his son to collect his rent. The tenants, believing that they will inherit the vineyard if the landowner dies without an heir, plot together and kill the landowner's son.


In telling the parable, Jesus is clearly drawing upon Isaiah 5:1-7, which is today's first reading and one that the priests and elders would have known well. Jesus doesn't, therefore, have to explain the symbolism of the parable; the Pharisees would have understood that the vineyard represented Israel, the landowner represented God, the servants represented the prophets, and the bad tenants represented the religious leaders. Yet Jesus nonetheless explains the meaning of the parable for his audience: the Kingdom of God will be taken from the unbelieving and given to the faithful. The chief priests and elders have condemned themselves with their answer to Jesus' question.

Today's Gospel has a parallel in Mark 12:1-12. There are some notable differences, however. In Matthew's version, the religious leaders condemn themselves; in Mark's Gospel, Jesus answers his own question. Matthew names the religious leaders as Pharisees and chief priests. Clearly this Gospel shows the tension that was mounting between Jesus and the Jewish religious leaders who thought that his message was dangerous. Matthew's Gospel was written about 70 years after Jesus' death and reflects the conflicts and tensions found in the Christian community for whom Matthew was writing. Many biblical scholars believe that the tension between Matthew's community and their Jewish neighbors can also be heard in today's reading.

This Gospel reminds us of the importance of listening to God's word. God speaks to us in many ways—through Scripture, through our Church tradition, in our Church's teaching, and through modern-day prophets. Are we attentive and receptive to God's word to us through these messengers?

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY HOARDING OR SHARING IN A PANDEMIC



Living in this time of global pandemic and restricted living we find even at the local level of our community, a reluctance to give up even a small part of what we have and instead HOARD that well beyond the level needed or useful. Even those in serious need sometimes hoard face masks, hand sanitizers, and food as if their only possessions are threatened by others around them. Some of this is almost instinctual but much is due to an imagined or real fear that others are going to deprive us of our material goods in this time of community and health insecurity.

This weekend (October 4) we celebrate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi who divested himself of extensive material wealth and possessions and gave that to the poor and dedicated his life to serving them by example and charity just as St. Vincent de Paul and his Vincentian followers have done during the last three centuries.

The opposite of <u>HOARDING</u> is <u>SHARING</u> what we do not need now or anytime in the near future with those who NOW need to get through this Pandemic period of insecurity and economic uncertainty. All of us need to survey our households and its possessions and see if we might find some items or resources that we can spare and share with the poor of the world around us. It is time to take inventory of our hoards and see if we can share with others whose needs are now very real.


