Juice has performed three times before for the dystonia cause. This is the fourth and final concert for dystonia.

Dystonia is a neurological movement disorder of which there are 13 known types and not a cure for any of them. All proceeds will go towards research to help find better treatments and perhaps a cure.

Juice Newton Fan Club President Paul Fowler has a form of Dystonia called Spasmodic Dysphonia which affect the vocal chords. "I am thrilled to have Juice help out with another benefit show. I am very fortunate to have known Juice and the band for so many years." Paul said.

The first benefit concert was held in 2006 and then was aided by the unforgettable Otha Young. Otha and Paul worked on the show along with the San Diego Dystonia Support and Advocacy Group Leader Martha Murphy. The next show was in 2009 and the last one was 2012.

Thus far these successful events have donated over \$37,500.00 towards research. Thank you Juice and the band for all of your support and willingness to help adults and children affected by Dystonia.

Juice at the Kate

Juice and the band performed in a Trio show in Old Saybrook, CT Apr 30, 2015. A good number of fan club members attended the show as did JNFC President Paul Fowler's parents. Some fans wrote in about the show at the Kathrine Hepburn Performing Arts Center.

Longtime fan club member Bill Volkman had this to say;

"Juice Newton travelled from San Diego, with Danny Dugan and Jay Cowley on backup vocals and guitars. They played at the intimate full house of people at the Kate Hepburn Cultural Arts Center in Old Saybrook, CT. This show was the replacement for the show scheduled in August 2014 when the trio was unable to fly to Connecticut due to airline flight cancellations.

Juice opened the show with "You Make Me Want To Make You Mine". She was very personable and chatty in between numbers. She explained what a challenge it is to present a show without the benefit of a band in the background. She told the audience that this was the first time they were doing this type of show since 7 months ago. The audience cheered at the opening of "Break It To Me Gently", the song for which Juice won a Grammy Award. Juice explained that she couldn't perform on her trusty 12-string guitar that she had used for 22 years, because the airlines had busted it up and it must now rest in peace. She performed "Angel of the Morning" with her regular 6-string guitar. She got a tremendous response of cheers when she finished that number. Later she performed a new song, not previously recorded on any of her albums, "Cry To Me".

Juice called for audience participation in clapping to the beat of the medley of "Queen of Hearts" and "Love's Been A Little Bit Hard on Me", while the three singers sang a cappella, without their guitars.

Juice closed with a tribute to Otha Young, her musical partner of 35 years, who died 5 years ago.

He wrote the hit, "The Sweetest Thing", which Juice performed as a finale, which drew a long standing ovation. The audience cheered until the performers came out for an encore and they sang "It's Late".

After the show, Juice came to the lobby with John Prpich, for greeting and autographs, and had CD's for sale."


