FIRE SEASON IS HERE!

Please call 911 immediately if you see or suspect a wildfire. Shelter Cove Fire wants to stress how important it is for you to make the 911 call immediately. Even if you are not sure what you are seeing is a wildfire dial 911. Catching a fire as early as possible is critical as local volunteer fire department resources are limited and aerial support/heavy equipment assistance takes time to respond to our remote location.

Protect Your Family & Protect Shelter Cove By Preparing for Wildfire & Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS)

<u>Have your Go Bag ready</u> and become familiar with signed (and designated) evacuation routes.

Be prepared for the potential of **Public Safety Power** <u>Shutoffs (PSPS)</u>. PSPS are implemented to protect life and property during times of prolonged dry, windy, and wildfire prone (red flag warning) weather by deenergizing <u>electrical lines</u> to specific areas in Shelter Cove. The District will make every effort to contact customers affected in advance of implementing a PSPS. Please make sure we have your most updated contact information including cell numbers and email addresses.

Keep our roads (evacuation routes) clear and free from obstructions. Please relocate all vehicles, boats and construction materials from Shelter Cove roadways and cul de sacs.

Chipper Days!

The next two Chipper Day will be on Saturday <u>August 14th</u> and Saturday <u>September 18th</u>. Please take advantage of this incredible opportunity by moving your woody material (to be chipped) to the roadside's edge with cut butts facing out. Please do not stack limbs over 5 feet high – just start a new pile. Tree trunks, stumps, rotten wood, rocks, and garbage cannot be chipped. Contact Shelter Cove Fire at

ONLINE BILL PAYMENT NOW AVAILABLE

The District is partnering with Allpaid to enable online utility payments through: <u>https://allpaid.com/</u>

You can use this simple online method to pay your District utility bill. The cost (fee) of using this service is 2.25% per (self-pay) transaction. Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover Card credit and debit cards are accepted. To complete an online payment, you will need your utility account number (located on the top left, second line of your utility bill) and the service street address. The District's website will also link to Allpaid's website.

GENERAL LABORER AND WATER OPERATOR JOBS AVAILABLE

General Laborer hourly rate: \$15.38 - \$25.48, with benefits. Full-time 40 hours/week.

Minimum qualifications:

Must have at least one-year experience general construction work or equivalent. Must have graduated high school or its equivalent. Must be computer literate. Must reside within one hour of the Shelter Cove area.

<u>Water Plant Operator</u> hourly rate: \$20.96 - \$29.94, with benefits. Full-time, 40 hours/week.

Minimum qualifications:

Must have one year of experience in the operation of domestic water treatment and distribution and possess a valid Grade 1 Water Treatment Plant Operator Certificate issued by California SWRCB.. Must have graduated high school or its equivalent. Must be computer literate. Must reside within one hour of the Shelter Cove area.

Application period: Open until filled. Final applicants must have a valid CA DMV issued driver's license and be able to pass a pre-employment physical and drug screening.
